Confronted with a Choice

Dear brothers and sisters,

We are constantly confronted with choices! From morning to evening not only of daily events, wants and food but choices of priorities in life: rich in God or rich in the world! The riches of the world says, "I am your life; you need me; without me you have no life." But God says, "One's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions." [Lk.12:15]

It is not a bad thing when your land produces plentifully; your business prospers; to receive a promotion and with it a pay increase; your investments increase in value; but what do you do with it? Being greedy, building a bigger barn by not being rich in Godly virtues is a wrong choice and acting foolishly. "Those who desire to be rich fall into temptation, ... into ruin and destruction." [1 Tim. 6:9]

Being rich toward God is the heart being drawn toward God; counting God as greater riches and using earthly riches to show how much you value God. If God had been his treasure, the farmer would have said, "God, thanks for making me prosper; it's all yours; let me rejoice in sharing my blessings with others; it is 'more blessed to give than to receive.'" [Acts. 20:35] St. Paul says, "Be rich in good works ... be ready to share ... take hold of that which is truly life." [1 Tim. 6:18-19]

In Atlanta, there was a restaurant called Church of God Grill. A visitor was curious and dialed the number. A man answered "Hello! Church of God Grill!" The visitor asked how that restaurant had been given such an unusual name, and the man said: "Well, we had a little mission down here, and we started selling chicken dinners after church on Sunday to help pay the bills. We did such a good business, that eventually we cut back on the church service. After a while we just closed down the church altogether and kept on serving chicken dinners. We kept the name we started with, and that's Church of God Grill." They forgot the purpose!

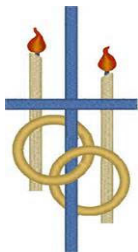
