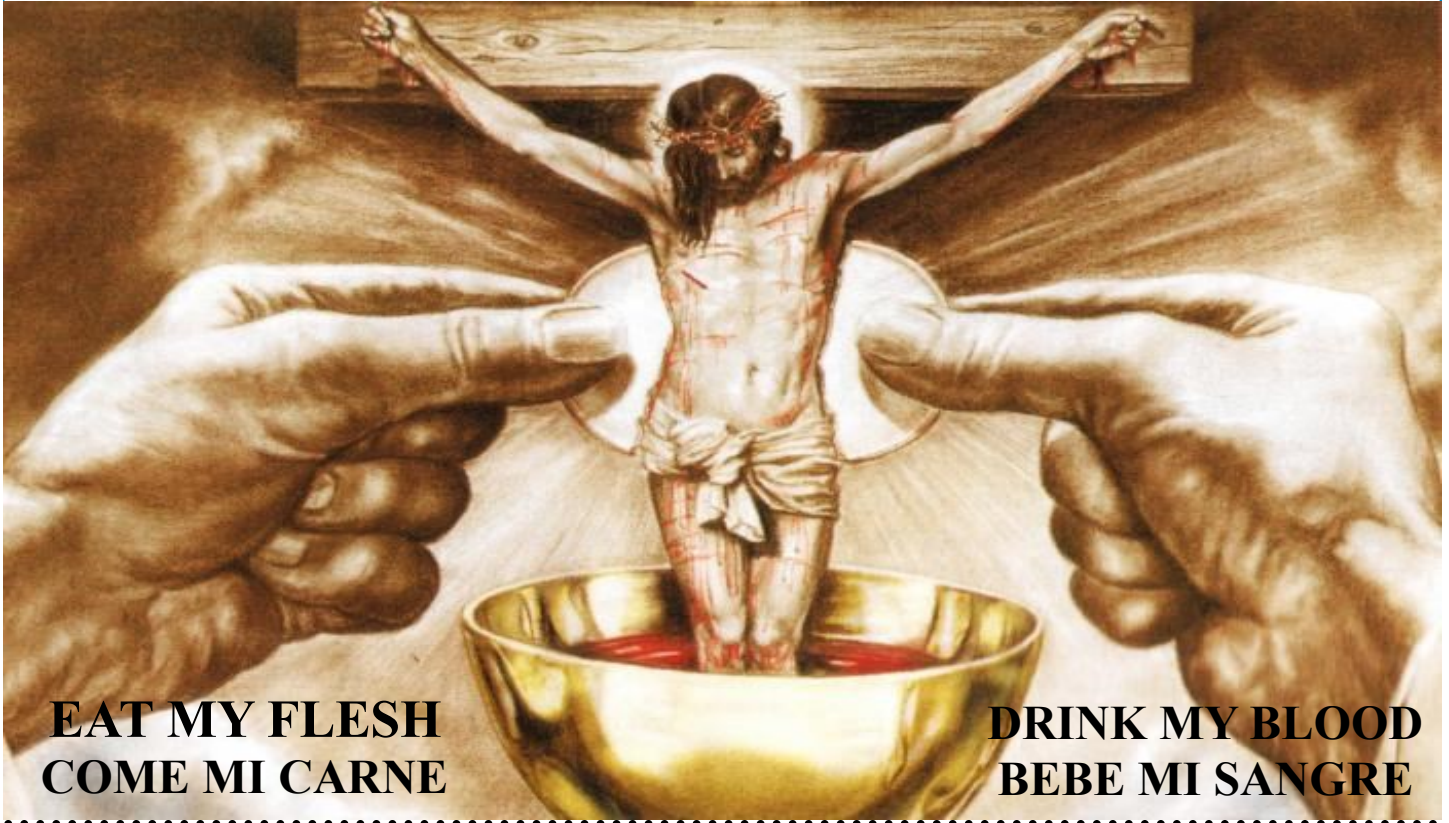

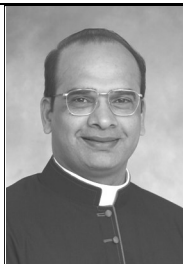

### 32. Being Filled with God

Dear brothers and sisters,

In one of my classes I spoke to the people, "Tell me, how I can get the air out of the tumbler I have in my hand?" One man said, "Suck it out with a pump." But I replied, "That would create a vacuum and shatter it." Finally after many suggestions, I picked up a pitcher and quietly filled the glass with water. "There," I said, "all the air is now removed." Thus we can explain the 'filling of God's grace in our lives in order to be victorious as the child of God.

Just working hard to eliminate sinful habits does not help you to experience the power of God. It makes you feel tired and burn-out. Rather, by allowing Christ to take full possession, fill you with His power, we activate our strength.

We read this week, 'Wisdom has set up her seven columns and invites us for a sumptuous dinner...; forsake foolishness (lack of understanding) and come to enjoy the food and be filled with wisdom. The seven pillars of wisdom are (1) counsel, (2) knowledge, (3) understanding, (4) might or strength, (5) power or authority, (6) riches and (7) honor. These are seven characteristics of wisdom. Therefore, if we eat the meal that is prepared by the Wisdom, we will be filled with all the characteristics of Wisdom. "Jesus is the Power and the Wisdom of God." (1Cor 1:24)

Jesus, the Living Bread, gives us in the Eucharist, His wisdom. So He says, "whoever eats my Body and drinks my Blood will have eternal life; He remains in us and we in Him". He fills us with His power. Until and unless we fill our lives with His grace and power, our emptiness, our vacuum, our meaninglessness will be with us. Therefore, be filled with Jesus and be guided by His power.

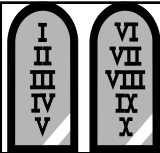

### "Parents are the most important factor

in the healthy development and faith formation of their children and adolescents!" Jim Burns has written an article entitled "How to Pass Your Faith to Your Kids" [p. 41]. He offers ten practical suggestions for parents to use as they nurture their child's spiritual development:

1. Be yourself.
2. Don't limit your conversations on spiritual matters to Sunday morning.
3. Let your kids catch you in the act of doing something spiritual.
4. Look for natural opportunities to raise spiritual issues.
5. Take the posture of a 'fellow-learner' as opposed to that of a 'teacher and student'.
6. Utilize media to launch discussions about God and the Christian life.
7. Have a plan for family devotional and prayer times.
8. Have fun with your kids.
9. Get involved in ministry together as a family.
10. Disciple and equip your kids.

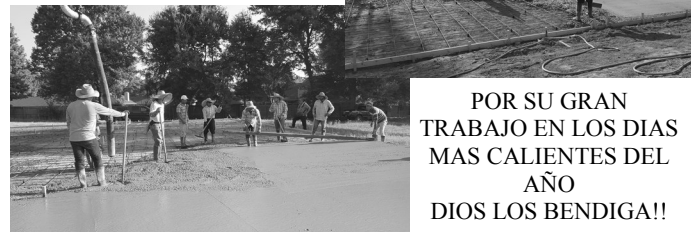

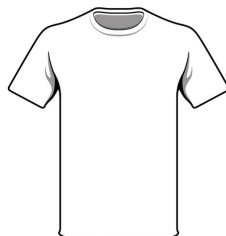
