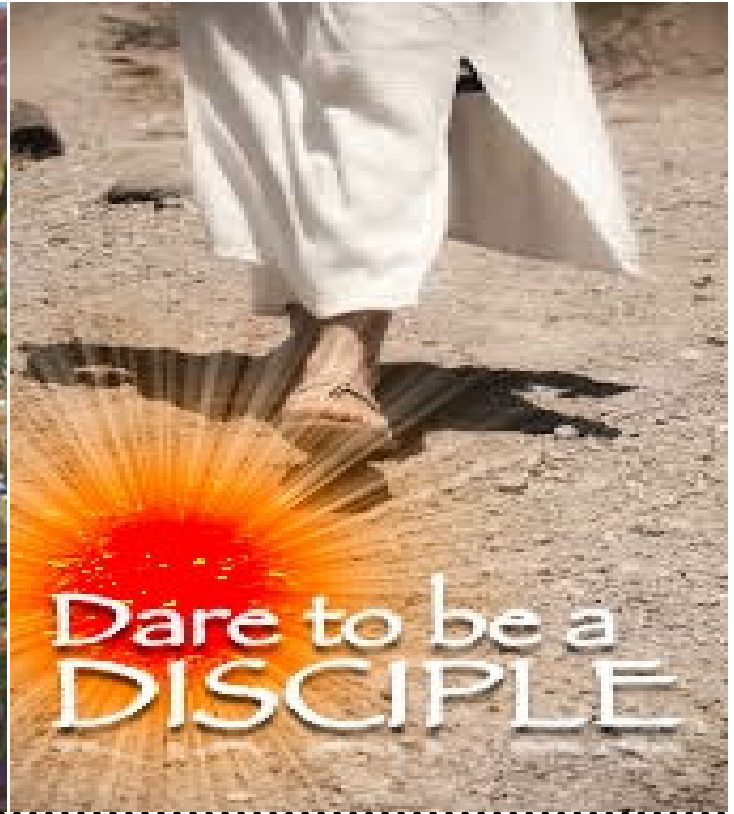

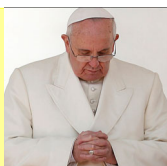

That those who administer justice may work with integrity and that the injustice which prevails in the world may not have the last word.



Ministry: Erred, Excused & Excited

Dear brothers and sisters,
During the Jewish Seder meal, prophet Elijah, the bearer of good news, is invoked with all the Seder participants standing around the table. When the front door of the house is opened, those assembled pray to God: "May the Spirit of Elijah, who enters our home at this hour, enter the hearts of all people...to love you ...with a desire to build a good world, of justice and freedom..." The ministry of Elijah continues in you and me to which Jesus called us to build the world of justice and freedom.

James and John erred about their mission by wanting to destroy the inhospitable Samaritans. Jesus rebuked them. A few others expected unusual comforts in their ministries; still others excused themselves offering varieties of reasons to minister - parents, brothers, sisters, children, job, land, travel, etc. If all these alibis are to escape responsible ministries, they become a yoke of slavery (Gal.5: 1) If we are slaves, it is hard to build a world of justice, love, peace and freedom!

Everyone is called to minister like Elijah. In God's plan, Elijah prepared, anointed Elisha to replace him and to succeed him. Elisha was excited! He slaughtered the bulls; used his plows as firewood to cook the meal; shared with the people and took over Elijah's mission with double-spirit. Nothing to fall back. All of us are necessary to the ministry but none of us is irreplaceable. Let us be excited and do our best! Be doubly blest!

The supreme test of ministry is this: 'For whom am I doing this?' Much that we call service to Christ is not such at all....If we are doing this for Christ, we shall not care for human reward or even recognition. Three propositions: i) Is this work from God? ii) for God? and iii) with God, as we are His co-workers with Him?"

Let us get excited like Elisha and be like Elijah prepare someone to succeed us in our ministering comes to end! With prayers and blessings!

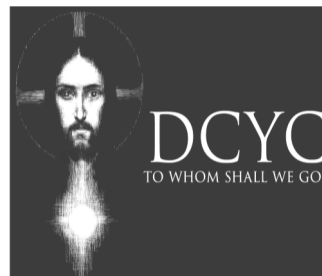
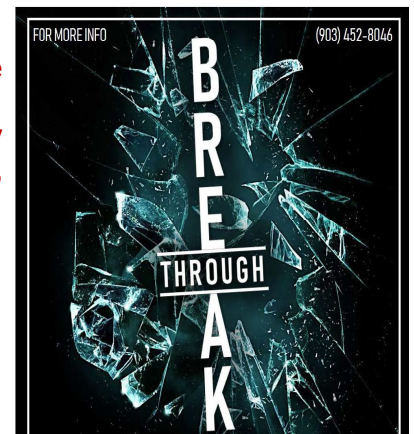

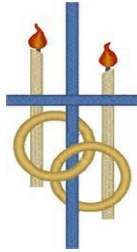
