Seekers, Sinners and Savior

Dear brothers and sisters,

God is a seeker and savor of those who are lost. This is the true nature of God. He began in the garden seeking Adam and Eve. [Gen. 3:8-9]. One of the most beautiful passages is in Ezekiel, "I will seek the lost, bring back the scattered, bind up the broken and strengthen the weak." [34:16] God does the initial seeking. [Lk.19:10]

Romans 3:11 (from Psalms 14:1-3) says, "There is none who seeks after God," because of our sinful inclinations. However, when Jesus came the people were looking for Him. "Everyone is looking for you;" [Mark 1: 37] the people brought the sick, those possessed by devils; the lepers came to Him; the large crowds came from towns to hear Him and followed Him.

Jesus was born to save sinners. [Mt. 1:21] This longing is in God and in us. [Lk.15:4] Zacchaeus, the little, the sinful and the rich man, expressed it publicly. Jesus, the seeker, spots out his seeker; and called him by name. "Those who diligently seek Me will find Me." [Prov. 8:17] Seek the Lord while He may be found." [Is 55:6] When you search for Me with all your heart you will find me." [Jer.29:13] "Seek Me that you may live." [Amos 5:4] "Seek and you shall find." [Mt.7:7]

We are called to live like the sunflowers, following the sun (Son). They do not despair on a grey, cloudy day, but on the contrary they turn towards each other to activate and exchange their inner light and strength. The reciprocal support and sharing of energy helps the sunflowers to easily overcome the rough days; and with renewed vigor wait for the sun in the morning!

Let us be 'seekers of God' and help our neighbors to seek and find the "seeking God" in their lives.

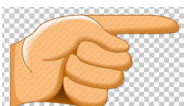

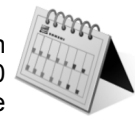

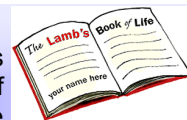

Why do we pray for the dead?

According to the Catholic Encyclopedia, the clearest Bible reference about prayers for the dead is from the Second Book of Maccabees. When soldiers were preparing the bodies of their slain comrades for burial

they discovered they were wearing amulets taken from a pagan temple which violated the law of Deuteronomy, so they prayed that God would forgive the sin these men had committed.

The New Testament echoes this notion in the second letter of Timothy when Paul prays for someone who died named Onesiphorus, saying: "May the Lord grant him to find mercy from the Lord on that day."

The Catechism of the Catholic Church also has something to say about prayers for the dead, stating: "All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven" (1030).

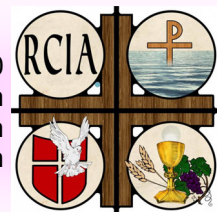

Diocese of Tyler: Ethics & Integrity / Safe Environment Program

General: An Acceptance Certificate for Service (ACS) is required of all Church personnel - Clergy, religious, seminarians, paid employees and volunteers engaged in ministry with minors and vulnerable adults. The ACS is granted after completing the required background check and Safe Environment training; commitment to the Code of Ethics and Integrity for Conduct of Church Personnel / Volunteers is also required.

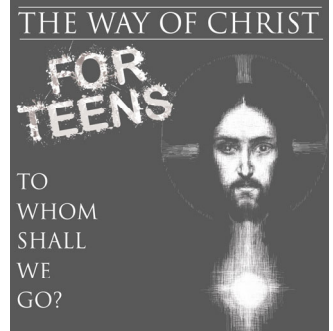
Background Check: Church personnel / volunteers must register with their parish administrator by filling out a registration form. Once they are entered into the database, they will receive e-mails about the background check and the Code of Conduct. The cost of the background check is \$16. **You must complete the Background Check and acknowledge the Code of Conduct before you may attend the training.**

Training: You must register for the training in the church office. Before service begins and every three years thereafter, church personnel / volunteers will take the training, in which they will view Praesidium's CASE video and participate in facilitated discussion. During years 2 and 3, all will complete ongoing education online.

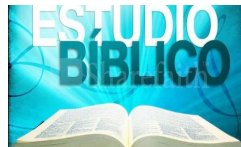

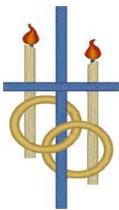
