### Christian Unity: Showing Unusual Kindness

Dear brothers and sisters,  
The 2020 theme for the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity has been selected. "They Showed Us Unusual Kindness." (Acts 28:2) This year the theme finds its origins in the Acts of the Apostles (Acts 27:18 – 28:10).

Fr. James Loughran, SA, Director of the Graymoor Ecumenical and Interreligious Institute noted that "as we gather annually throughout the world to pray for the unity of Christians we are reminded of the importance of the need for "unusual kindness" in the dialogue that leads to growth in unity. We do this in a world where separation and division hinder the quest for Christian Unity. In 2020, we are being called to show unusual kindness towards one another."

During the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity, Churches of all faiths are called together to form a vibrant and prayerful witness for Christian Unity by heeding Jesus's prayer "that they all may be one" through their unusual kindness that a divided people were drawn closer together." (Acts 27:18 – 28:10)

Each one of us pray for unity of our families, nations and states and countries. But, we fail to unite our thoughts or prayers to actions. We have five fingers in one hand. Individually they're nothing; they point out something or someone; but when we curl them together into a single unit, they form a weapon that is terrible to behold. Thus, if actions for unity of Christians comes out of our churches, the powerful prayer of Jesus will come true. The Devil's chief device was disunity and division.

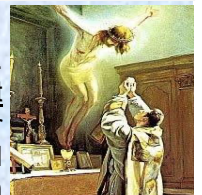
Let us "show some unusual kindness" randomly and bring the love of Christ to existence in our relationships; and defeat the devil.

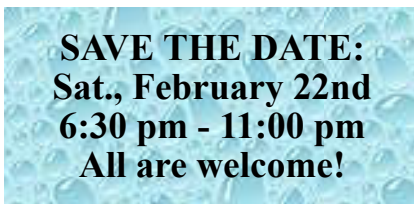

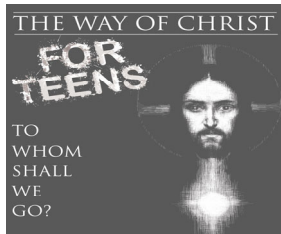

**Diocese of Tyler: Ethics & Integrity / Safe Environment Program**

**General:** An Acceptance Certificate for Service (ACS) is required of all Church personnel - Clergy, religious, seminarians, paid employees and volunteers engaged in ministry with minors and vulnerable adults.

The ACS is granted after completing the required background check and Safe Environment training; commitment to the Code of Ethics and Integrity for Conduct of Church Personnel / Volunteers is also required.

**Background Check:** Church personnel / volunteers must register with their parish administrator by filling out a registration form in the church office. Once they are entered into the database, they will receive e-mails about the background check and the Code of Conduct. The cost of the background check is \$16. **You must complete the Background Check and acknowledge the Code of Conduct before you may attend the training.**

**Training:** You must register for the training in the church office. Before service begins and every three years thereafter, church personnel / volunteers will take the training, in which they will view Praesidium's CASE video and participate in facilitated discussion. During years 2 and 3, all will complete ongoing education online.
