Dear brothers sisters,
 A young girl once consulted with her priest "I cannot stick it out any longer. I am the only Catholic in the factory where I work. I get nothing but taunts and sneers. It is more than I can stand. I am going to resign." "Will you tell me," asked the priest, "where lights are placed?" "What has that to do with it?" the young Catholic asked him rather bluntly. "Never mind," the priest replied. "Answer my question: Where are lights placed?" "I suppose in dark places," she replied. "Yes, and that is why you have been put in that factory where there is such spiritual darkness and where there is no other Catholic to shine for the Lord."

The young Catholic realized for the first time the opportunity that was hers. She felt she could not fail God by allowing her light to go out. She went back to the factory with renewed determination to let her light shine in that dark corner. Before long, she was the means of leading nine other girls to the Light.

Jesus came as the light of the world. He went thru the lands of darkness – Zabulun, Nephtali, the Galilee of the Gentiles. He began preaching "repentance"- an act of conversion of hearts and we see the light he brings. As he walked through the land he called his disciples to the work of being a light.

Today you and I are called to this mission to "be a light." There is a candle in every soul! It is a Christian's specific duty to furnish guiding light to the lost. Do we recognize the assignment? Who suffers if we do not perform it? Jesus said, "You are the light of the world...Let your light shine before men..." The light we have to give to the world is the light which we have received from Him.

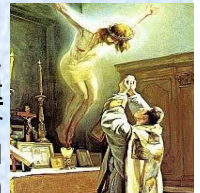
Therefore, "Go Light your World." A song by *Kathy Troccoli*. Read it and meditate; sing it and live it!

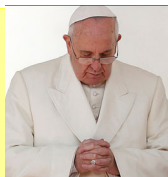

The Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes & World Day of the Sick - Feb. 11th

One hundred and sixty years ago, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared on eighteen occasions to Bernadette Soubirous, a very poor, 14-year-old girl, in a cave situated just outside the Village of Lourdes. The first of the apparitions took place on February 11th, the day we celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes.

On this same day twenty six years ago, Pope John Paul II declared February 11th the World Day of the Sick. The Holy Father, Pope Francis, has written a message that all members should read on the theme of this year's two-part celebration, the image of the "Mater Ecclesia".

In his message, the Holy Father points out that, just like "Mary's maternal vocation for all humanity," the Church, with its long standing tradition of service to the sick, keeps its own "maternal vocation to the needy and to the sick. [That tradition] has found concrete expression throughout the two thousand years of her history in an impressive series of initiatives on behalf of the sick [...and] continues to the present day throughout the world".

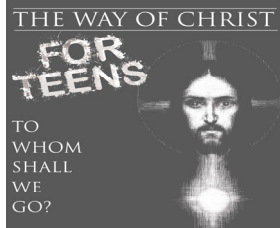

Diocese of Tyler: Ethics & Integrity / Safe Environment Program

General: An Acceptance Certificate for Service (ACS) is required of all Church personnel - Clergy, religious, seminarians, paid employees and volunteers engaged in ministry with minors and vulnerable adults.

The ACS is granted after completing the required background check and Safe Environment training; commitment to the Code of Ethics and Integrity for Conduct of Church Personnel / Volunteers is also required.

Background Check: Church personnel / volunteers must register with their parish administrator by filling out a registration form in the church office. Once they are entered into the database, they will receive e-mails about the background check and the Code of Conduct. The cost of the background check is \$16. **You must complete the Background Check and acknowledge the Code of Conduct before you may attend the training.**

Training: You must register for the training in the church office. Before service begins and every three years thereafter, church personnel / volunteers will take the training, in which they will view Praesidium's CASE video and participate in facilitated discussion. During years 2 and 3, all will complete ongoing education online.

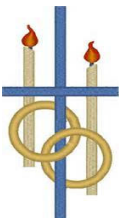
