Christ's Body and Blood Builds Our Life

Dear brothers and sisters,
 Blessings of the Feast of Corpus Christi. I congratulate 115 of our children who have received the Lord Jesus for the first time in the Eucharist. It is very appropriate for them to receive the Eucharist on the feast of Corpus Christi. May we all grow in the

Lord Jesus.

The early church welcomed all baptized members regardless of age or status, connecting John 3:5 'unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the Kingdom of God,' with John 6:53, 'unless you eat the flesh of the son of man and drink his blood, you have no life in you,' and established what is necessary for participation in the Christian community. Now, the church teaches that all who attained the age of reasoning may receive the Holy Communion. So, we become members and build the mystical Body of Christ – loving God and our neighbors – and living a new life in Christ.

A young woman had a very rough past, involving alcohol, drugs, etc. She had her change of heart and became a faithful member of a church. She loved the pastor's son, and planned to marry him. The church members began to argue on this matter. The woman was upset. The pastor's son stood up to speak, "My fiancé's past is not what is on trial here. What you are questioning is the ability of the blood of Jesus to wash away sin. Today you have put the blood of Jesus on trial. So, does it wash away sin or not?" The whole church began to weep as they realized that they had been slandering the blood of Jesus Christ and failing to love the woman's new life in Christ.

Too often, even as Christians, we bring up the past and use it as a weapon against our brothers and sisters. Forgiveness is a very foundational part of Christ's body and blood. If the Eucharist does not cleanse your ENEMY completely then it cannot cleanse YOU completely! As we love Christ, let us build the Body of Christ. *Msgr. Xavier*

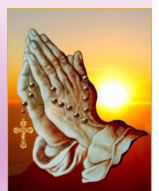

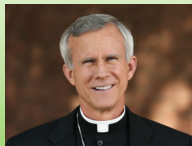

The Diocesan Catholic Youth Conference originally scheduled for this summer will be rescheduled for a weekend this fall and is expected to take place at Bishop Gorman Catholic High School in Tyler. The event is open to all high school students currently enrolled in grades 9-12 for the 2020-2021 school year. We will keep you updated as we get more information.

Does the bread cease to be bread and the wine cease to be wine in the Eucharist?

Yes. In order for the whole Christ to be present - body, blood, soul, and divinity - the bread and wine cannot remain, but must give way so that his glorified Body and Blood may be present. Thus in the Eucharist the bread ceases to be bread in substance, and becomes the Body of Christ, while the wine ceases to be wine in substance, and becomes the Blood of Christ. As St. Thomas Aquinas observed, Christ is not quoted as saying, " *This bread is my body,*" but " *This is my body*" (*Summa Theologiae*, III q. 78, a. 5).

Is it fitting that Christ is present in the Eucharist under the appearances of bread and wine?

Yes, for this way of being present corresponds perfectly to the sacramental celebration of the Eucharist. Jesus Christ gives himself to us in a form that employs the symbolism inherent in eating bread and drinking wine. Furthermore, being present under the appearances of bread and wine, Christ gives himself to us in a form that is appropriate for human eating and drinking. Also, this kind of presence corresponds to the virtue of faith, for the presence of the Body and Blood of Christ cannot be detected or discerned by any way other than faith. That is why St. Bonaventure affirmed: "There is no difficulty over Christ's being present in the sacrament as in a sign; the great difficulty is in the fact that He is really in the sacrament, as He is in heaven. And so believing this is especially meritorious" (*In IV Sent.*, dist. X, P. I, art. un., qu. I). On the authority of God who reveals himself to us, by faith we believe that which cannot be grasped by our human faculties (cf. *Catechism*, no. 1381). [source: USCCB.org]

The Meaning of Vocation St. John Paul

The process of a vocation:

The Lord has given you a heart open to great horizons; do not be afraid to commit your life completely to the service of Christ and His Gospel! Listen to Him as He says again today: "The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few." The lack of workers for God's harvest was already a challenge in Gospel times, even for Jesus Himself. (Mt 9:38).

Do not be afraid to go out into the streets and public places like the first apostles, who preached Christ and the good news of salvation in the squares of cities, towns, and villages. This is no time to be ashamed of the Gospel. It is the time to preach it from the rooftops. Do not be afraid to break out of comfortable and routine modes of living in order to take up the challenge of making Christ known in the modern "metropolis." It is you who must "go out into the byroads" and invite everyone you meet to the banquet, which God has prepared for His people. The Gospel must not be kept hidden because of fear or indifference. It was never meant to be hidden away in private. It has to be put on a stand so that people may see its light and give praise to our heavenly Father. In clearly detecting this vocation that comes from God, man experiences the sense of his own insufficiency. He even attempts to defend himself against the responsibility of this calling. And so, almost without wanting it, the calling becomes an interior dialogue with God and, at times, even results in becoming a battle with God. Faced with the hesitancy and difficulties human reason sets up, God offers the power of His grace. And by the power of this grace, man is able to fulfill his calling. [to continue]

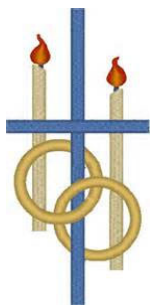
