Christ Reveals Our Differences

Dear brothers and sisters,
Christian life is shepherding and caring for one another – being our brother's or sister's keeper and being a priest, a prophet and king. On the feast of Christ, the King, the last Sunday of the Liturgical Year, the Lord invites us to look into ourselves, our personal lives with one another; my way or the highway (a goat's life,) god's way is my way (sheep's life,) belonging and being for others. The church and political leaders may neglect or ignore their people; but we as individuals are not supposed to, but be caring for one another in good times and in bad.

A young lady called a Card Shop. Do you remember those wedding invitations I ordered last week? Well, I was wondering if it is too late to make a few changes in them." The shopkeeper said, "give me the new information, lady, and I shall check." "OK. It's a different date, a different church and a different man." It is quite impossible to be happily married to another or live in a family peacefully, if one does not first get a 'divorce from oneself'. "My way or the highway" does not work in God's family or in His kingdom.

Christ, the King, is to judge between cattle to cattle; people to people; the sheep and the lambs; and the rams and goats; by which latter he meant persons of superior power and authority, of greater wealth and riches, and of more wisdom and knowledge, at least in their own conceits. He is to judge sinners and the ungodly; sincere Christians and hypocrites; righteous and unrighteous. (Is. 14:9; Zech.10:3; Matt. 25:35-36). The SIX things we did reveals our Christian living; our identity; our citizenship and our belongingness.

Han Urs said, "What you are is God's gift to you, what you become is your gift to God." Therefore, let us reveal our goodness through our Christian love and care, and prove our differences! Blessings!

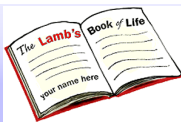

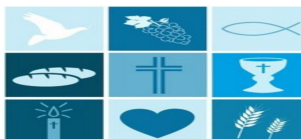

CATECHIST WANTED!

Why do we pray for the dead?



According to the Catholic Encyclopedia, the clearest Bible reference about prayers for the dead is from the Second Book of Maccabees. When soldiers were preparing the bodies of their slain comrades for burial they discovered

they were wearing amulets taken from a pagan temple which violated the law of Deuteronomy, so they prayed that God would forgive the sin these men had committed.

The New Testament echoes this notion in the second letter of Timothy when Paul prays for someone who died named Onesiphorus, saying: "May the Lord grant him to find mercy from the Lord on that day."

The Catechism of the Catholic Church also has something to say about prayers for the dead, stating: "All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven" (1030).

May the souls of all the faithful departed Rest in Peace!
Pray for those who have no one to pray for them!

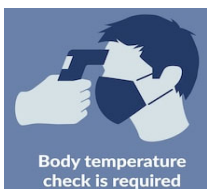

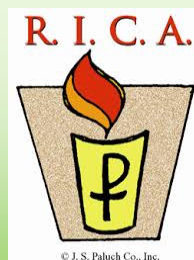

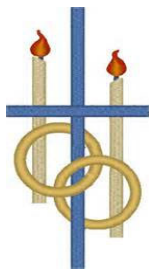
