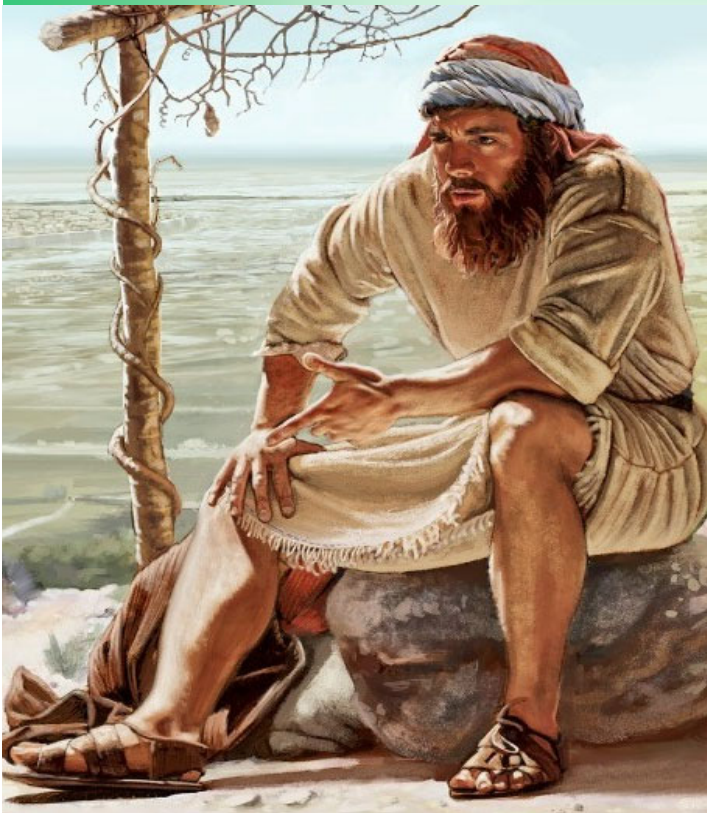

No Fussing but Fishing

Dear brothers and sisters,

Someone gave these tips to become a better fisherman: Fish at the right time; become a student of fishing; fish where others aren't willing to fish; practice, practice, practice; have a positive attitude. These tips could be applied for every

Christian living.

Jonah was fussing a lot about God calling him to prophesy the destruction of Nineveh - he attempted to flee from "the presence of God" by going to Jaffa, sailing to Tarshish, etc. The sailors blamed Jonah and threw him overboard. In the belly of the fish, Jonah prayed & vowed to God for 3 days. Jonah's fussing didn't work; therefore, he began fishing the men of Nineveh.



The disciples were fishing. Jesus saw them and invited them to be fishers of men. They left their business and began fishing men - waiting for the right time, becoming the disciples of Jesus, going where none was willing to go, practiced daily and always with a positive attitude - God was working with them.

During the "Year of St. Joseph," let us look at how Joseph handled the situation - his brothers sold him to the Ishmaelites; sold him to Potiphar; because of Potiphar's wife's lustful desire he was thrown into prison, etc. In all these situations he didn't fuss about anything; but sought God's presence and His will; and God was with him to bless him in everything he did.

Someone said, "The only thing I love more than fishing is being a Dad/Mom/Grandpa/Grandma. Yes, if you live this calling, it is fishing men in our life. There are some fish that cannot be caught. It's not that they are faster or stronger than other fish, they're just touched by something extra. Fish them with patience and the Lord will work wonders in your life. Blessings! Msgr. Xavier

Feb. 2016	Searching for land for Catholic Cemetery in city of Longview
Mar. 2016	Determined that a new Cemetery is not allowed in City; Found State Regulations regarding building Cemeteries and Columbarium in Texas. Began searching for cemetery land 3 miles outside Longview city limits.
May 2016	Considering a potential donation of land between White Oak and Longview; Relator (Skip Morton) assists in searching for available land; determined that no nearby unencumbered land is available with easy access.
Jun. 2016	Began pursuit of Columbarium on church property as per State Regulations; hired Hugman Architecture to assist with preliminary design and permit and rezoning.
Oct. 2016	Filed rezoning application w/ city of Longview for Columbarium
Nov. 2016	Longview Planning and Zoning Committee recommended approval of rezoning
Dec. 2016	Longview City Council approved rezoning request for Columbarium. Hugman Architecture developed cost estimate for Columbarium.

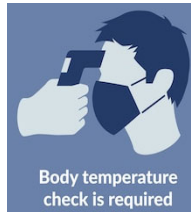
