Abrahamic Covenant with Us

Dear brothers and sisters,

In making a covenant with Abraham, God promised to bless his / our descendants and make them / us His own special people. In return, Abraham was [we're] to remain faithful to God and to serve as a channel through which God's blessings

could flow to the rest of the world. (Gen. 12:1-3)

Abram becomes Abraham at the age of 75; he left his pagan land to an unknown land God would show him everyday; believed about the promise of decedents, but no child; he listened to his wife; but God rejected his wife's action to have a child through a slave girl; God renewed His covenant again; tested his faith; and fulfilled this covenant in Isaac. (Gen. 17:19)

After a few hundred years, [with the 4th generation] the

promise continued with Joseph [of Old Testament]. God was with him and rescued him from all his troubles and gave him "grace & wisdom" After 40 generations, with Joseph [of New Testament], foster father of Jesus, God renewed His covenant with His chosen people.



God also revealed His covenant in

Jesus at His baptism and transfiguration, which is continued in us, through our baptism, showing that in Him / in us the Law and the Prophetic words are being fulfilled. All that we are asked to do is, as the psalmist says, "walk before the Lord... that will lead you to the land of the living."

The blessings to Abraham will be ours: "I will bless you; I will make your name great; you will be a blessing to the next generation." Be a blessing to others, as Abraham and Joseph were.

Fasting & Abstinence

• Fasting is defined as having one full meal a day, and is required only on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This requirement is for ages 18 to 59, but younger and older may participate.



• During Lent abstinence from meat on Friday's is obligatory in the United States, as elsewhere, for all Catholics age 14 until death.

Getting caught up in the rubrical requirements, however, misses the point. Fasting is meaningless unless our hearts fast from obstacles blocking our way to true discipleship.

5 Fundamental Needs of Teenagers

- 3. THE NEED TO BE TRANSPARENT: Teenagers rarely have the freedom to be transparent today, especially with one another. It is too dangerous to be vulnerable in a peer-dominated world focused on image and popularity. Teens long for the opportunity to be transparent about their doubts, concerns, fears, insecurities, hopes, and dreams, and to have the confidence of knowing they will not be judged, but loved and supported. In fact, this is necessary in order for them to grow in self-awareness and self-esteem. A small group where trust has been established creates an environment where transparency can take place
- 4 . THE NEED TO ENGAGE IN CRITICAL THINKING ABOUT FAITH AND LIFE: Teens are transitioning from concrete thinking to abstract thinking and are able to conceptualize ideas such as love, justice, fairness, and truth. They are also capable of pondering the big questions in life such as: Is there a God? Do I need religion? Can I know God's plan for my life? In addition, they are in the process of establishing independence and becoming their own person. Deep down they desire to be treated as adults and no longer want to be told what to do or what to believe. They are critically evaluating what they have been raised to believe and are not that interested in answers to questions they are not asking. Thought-provoking questions, lively discussion, dialogue, and freedom of expression engage teenagers in To be continued... critical thinking.


