Divine Mercy Begins at Home

Dear brothers and sisters,

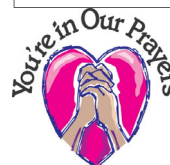
This week, we celebrate the Divine Mercy Sunday. For the next 40 days, Jesus would meet his friends to extend His mercy and renew His love. In the Bible, mercy and compassion are mentioned in various forms hundreds of times, as God's nature. Instead of giving us what we deserve, God has shown mercy again and again, not to take away our responsibility, but to give us a chance to repent and be saved.

We are commanded to be merciful as God is merciful! [Luke 6:36] The merciful man does good for his own soul... [Prov. 11:17] Jesus says, "Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy." [Mt. 5:7] Because the weightier matters of the law are justice, mercy and faith. [Mt. 23:23] Therefore, we are called to 'Execute true justice, show mercy and compassion to everyone.' St. James says, "Mercy triumphs over judgment." Do we have a limit? Not in our families.

Our life is like the dial of a clock. The hands are God's hands, passing over and over again - the short Hand of Discipline and the long Hand of Mercy. Slowly and surely the Hand of Discipline must pass, and God speaks at each strike; but over and over passes the Hand of Mercy, showering down sixty-fold of blessing for each stroke of discipline or trial; and both hands are fastened to one secure point, unchanging Heart of a God of Love.

St. Joseph was merciful towards Mary when he found her with child; did not want to put her to shame...! We can ask ourselves: What have we done with the given opportunities? In Mark 5:19, Jesus says, "Go home to your people... tell them the mercy God has shown to you." Have you received mercy from God, please show it to others everyday. Mercy is Divine nature in us.

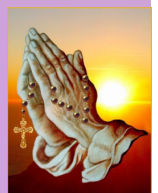

for devout communicants on Mercy Sunday,
and**

**the plenary indulgence for Mercy Sunday
devotions that was instituted several years ago by
Pope John Paul II? Are they the same thing?**

The main difference, of course, is that an "indulgence" is something offered to the faithful by the Church, as the keeper of the keys of the kingdom, with authority to "bind and loose." (Mt 16:17-19)

The special graces of Mercy Sunday, on the other hand, were promised directly by our Lord, through a prophetic revelation given to St. Faustina (see Diary of St. Faustina, 699).

The Church has not officially ruled that this particular promise was an authentic supernatural revelation, but the Church has discerned, in various ways, that there is nothing that violates Catholic doctrine in this promise.

Last time we continued our Faith series Entitled "The Search," and video entitled "Why a God?" The video delved into the origins of faith and creation. How God is everywhere and everything. FIVE WAYS FOR YOUNG ADULTS TO GET INVOLVED IN THE PARISH

- 1. Pray regularly with your parish.** Go to Mass every week and participate in the celebration of the Eucharist. Join in opportunities for Eucharistic Adoration and receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation regularly.
- 2. Find your niche.** Most parishes offer a variety of ministries, committees and councils that do good work in the community and for the parish. There is almost always some ministry that will truly speak to your heart and fit with the type of person God has made you to be.
- 3. Volunteer your expertise.** Sometimes, the work you do outside the church is needed within the church. Volunteer to lead a project repairing something, planting, weeding a flower bed or maybe even teaching as a catechist or coaching the youth sports teams.
- 4. Make friends.** Many young adults feel alone until they look around at Mass and find people in the pews like them. Stick around for the after Mass, say hello and invite them to your place for brunch, or just start with exchanging phone numbers. And if that doesn't work, then sit closer to them at next week's Mass and catch them before they fly out the door.
- 5. If it isn't happening, make it happen.** Churches do not need to encompass all that is going on in the life of the parish. If you don't see something you would love to see happen, start doing it! Start a small group at your home, begin a sports club with fellow young adults at a local park, develop a running club or begin doing regular ministry for the homebound at your parish. Start doing it, and invite others to join you.

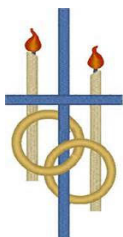
