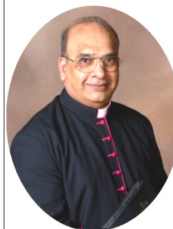

### Christ IS in Christian's Love

Dear brothers and sisters,  
I wish all the mothers a "Happy Mothers Day." God created the mothers for each one that we might see His love in them. None can take that away from us. Jesus was sent to show us the depth of God's love: he called us friends and told us about everything from the Father God.

From the moment 'our heart began to beat, the breath of God is poured into our hearts' and we are bonded in Him. He abides in us forever. It is up to us to remain in Him and in our loved ones - is it doable? Yes. If we want.

Begin making a complete commitment to stay in love; communicate openly & honestly to the person you love; accept the differences; expect the best but set a reasonable standard; encourage the person; be a good listener; forgive early & often; apologize for your mistakes; take time to be together; and develop a shared goal. All these could be found in St. Joseph, in our parents, especially in our mothers. Every person knows that he/she lives in his/her mother's love.

In March 2010 an Australian mother gave birth to twins. The doctors declared one dead and the other living. For 20 min. the doctors tried to resuscitate the dead baby. No success. As the parents were prepared to say goodbye to their new-born, the mother asked for her baby to hold for a few minutes; she held the baby tight to her chest. In a few minutes, the baby boy began to cry & came back to life. The Mother's love can give life even to the dead baby.

Our Christian love can give life to our dead relationships. Once you commit yourself and develop a goal, you would never give up; but will achieve the goal. Our mother's love could be lived between spouses and between Christians. Thus our love becomes Christ's love or Christian love and helps us to remain in each other.

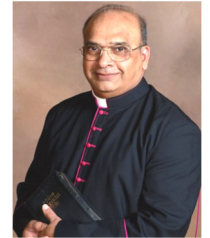

Those registered to receive the Sacraments must attend at their respective scheduled time.

All parents need to drive through at the back of the church [in front of the Faith Formation building], and stay in the car until your children have their temperature taken & drop them before you leave. [If they have a fever, please do not bring them to the class or to the Mass.]

**Note:** Children need to wear their masks.

### Dress Code

#### First Holy Communion & Confirmation

**Girls:** Dresses are NOT to be shorter than the knee or longer than the ankle. NO FORMALS. For those receiving First Holy Communion, the dress code is white; for the Confirmands, any color is permitted. Dress shoes or dress sandals (no tennis shoes). No dresses with spaghetti straps or without sleeves will be permitted. Without proper dress you may not be permitted to participate in the sacraments.



**Boys - First Holy Communion:** Dress shirt must be white, long or short sleeve. Dress pants may be white, navy blue or black. Ties requested - white, navy blue or black;

**Boys - Confirmation:** Dress shirt of any solid color. Dark dress pants - navy blue or black; Dark shoes and socks - dress shoes preferred (no tennis shoes please);

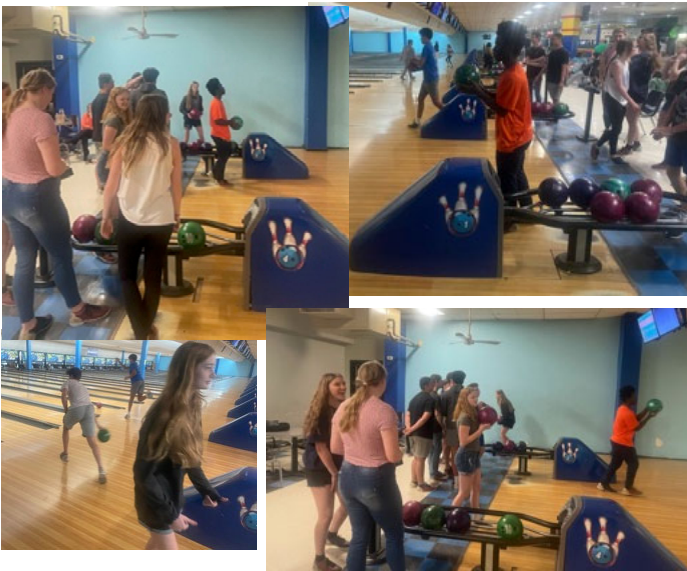

## YDisciple

### PROGRAMS DON'T MAKE DISCIPLES, DISCIPLES DO.

**Virtue of the Week: Legacy - The strength to hand down a virtuous tradition and memory of your actions.**

This week we continued our video series *The Search*. The topic was "Who is Jesus?"

We reflected on how Jesus was born in a stable, not a home. How Jesus was found teaching the elders in the temple when just a boy. How Jesus himself was baptized by John the Baptist and said this has to be done, and how the Spirit of God descended like a dove and said, this is my son with whom I am well pleased. How Jesus was crucified, the 12 disciples were killed defending and testifying to his name. 2000 years later here we are, and Jesus is the most widely known name to date. How there are basically 4 biographies written about him in the Bible. Who else in history can say that? Not even Julius Cesar. Jesus's Legacy will continue to transcend our time here on earth.

## FIVE WAYS FOR YOUNG ADULTS TO GET INVOLVED IN THE PARISH

- 1. Pray regularly with your parish.** Go to Mass every week and participate in the celebration of the Eucharist. Join in opportunities for Eucharistic Adoration and receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation regularly.
- 2. Find your niche.** Most parishes offer a variety of ministries, committees and councils that do good work in the community and for the parish. There is almost always some ministry that will truly speak to your heart and fit with the type of person God has made you to be.
- 3. Volunteer your expertise.** Sometimes, the work you do outside the church is needed within the church. Volunteer to lead a project repairing something, planting, weeding a flower bed or maybe even teaching as a catechist or coaching the youth sports teams.
- 4. Make friends.** Many young adults feel alone until they look around at Mass and find people in the pews like them. Stick around for the after Mass, say hello and invite them to your place for brunch, or just start with exchanging phone numbers. And if that doesn't work, then sit closer to them at next week's Mass and catch them before they fly out the door.
- 5. If it isn't happening, make it happen.** Churches do not need to encompass all that is going on in the life of the parish. If you don't see something you would love to see happen, start doing it! Start a small group at your home, begin a sports club with fellow young adults at a local park, develop a running club or begin doing regular ministry for the homebound at your parish. Start doing it, and invite others to join you.

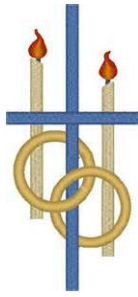
