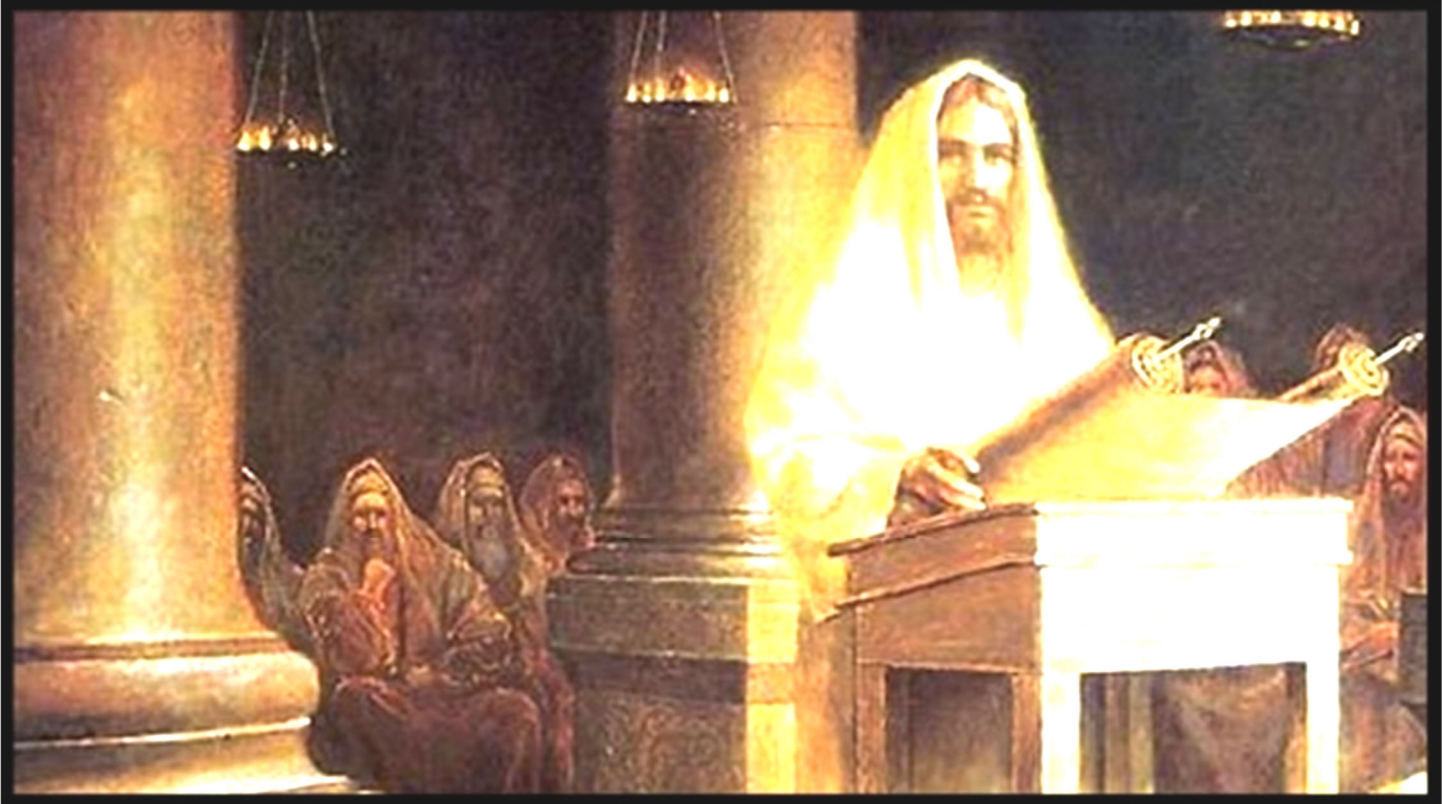

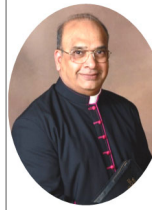

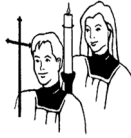

### SUMMER HOLIDAYS

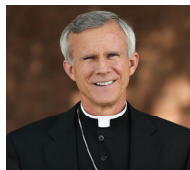

## Evanqelize, Catechize and Form Disciples

### My child has received First Communion and Confirmation, What is next?

1. Receive the Eucharist as often as you can with deep belief in our Lord who is truly present, body and soul, humanity and divinity who becomes present at the words of consecration and who comes into our lives, into our very beings, assimilates us into himself, through the reception of the Eucharist.
2. Be a Catholic: By the reception of the Eucharist we become tabernacles, with our Lord contained within our very selves. That's what really makes Catholics Catholic. Take away the Eucharist, and we're like everyone else. There's no difference. Let us be Catholics. Bring your children for Mass and to receive communion.

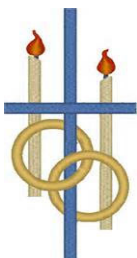
