Pro-Life: Month 4

We observe month four of fetal development (please see the poster in the church foyer.) The baby's brain has begun maturing - a process that will continue until she is about 14 years old. Her taste buds; Nutrients consumed by her mother are passed on to her within an hour or two. Fine hair begins to grow on her head, eyebrows and eyelashes. Facial expressions similar to the baby's parents can be seen at this time. This month rapid eye movements have been recorded, a sign of dreaming. The baby is about nine inches long.

Deliverance Conference

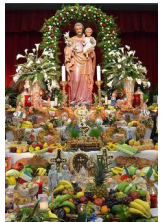

They prayed to Saint Joseph, their patron saint, for his intercession. At last the skies opened sending down the life-giving water and the fields flourished. To show their gratitude they prepared a table with three tiers. The tiers are to remember the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. They filled the table with food from the harvest of their fields. They thanked St. Joseph for his prayers, then took the food to the less fortunate.

Every year on March 19 we celebrate Saint Joseph and remember what he did for the Sicilian people. For this year of St. Joseph, we will celebrate each month.

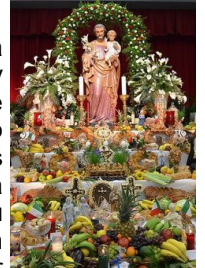

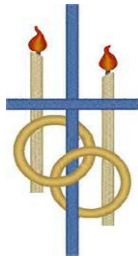
VACACIONES DE VERANO
