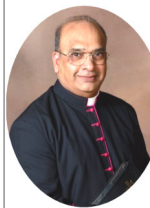

Blessing Shared is Multiplied



Dear brothers and sisters,

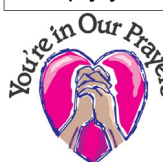
R. G. LeTourneau (1888–1969) was a Christian industrialist who dedicated his life to “being a businessman for God.” He was hugely successful, designing and developing his own line of earth-moving equipment.

He was the maker of nearly 300 inventions, and had hundreds of patents in his lifetime. As he succeeded financially, he increased his giving to the point where he was giving 90% of his income to the Lord’s work. He said, I shovel out the money, and God shovels it back; but God has a bigger shovel.” You may be thinking, “I could give 90% too, if I was a millionaire.” Maybe so, but LeTourneau didn’t start out wealthy. Sharing of his blessings multiplied his blessings.



“To bless” means, to speak good or to do good for another. *Firstly*, God blesses us; God blessed Abraham by saying, “I will make you into a great nation and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing.” (Gen. 12:2). *Secondly*, People bless God. [Psalm 103:1-2] Expressing praise to God is blessing Him. *Thirdly*, spoken by God or people over things. Deut. 28:4-5: “The fruit of your womb will be blessed, the crops of your land and your livestock, etc.” *Fourthly*, spoken by one person to another, speaking good and doing good to another.

If a man from Baal-Shalishah’s 20 loaves could feed 100s of people; a boy’s 5 barley loaves & 2 fish could feed thousands of people, our blessing shared with God’s blessing could bring more and more blessings. Jesus says, “Give, and it will be given to you. ...For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.” [Luke 6:38] This can be applied to say or do for others – good or bad. Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows. [Gal. 6:7; 2 Cor. 9:6] Be a blessing, and multiply your blessings! *Msgr. Xavier*

Facial expressions similar to the baby's parents can be seen at this time. This month rapid eye movements have been recorded, a sign of dreaming. The baby is about nine inches long.

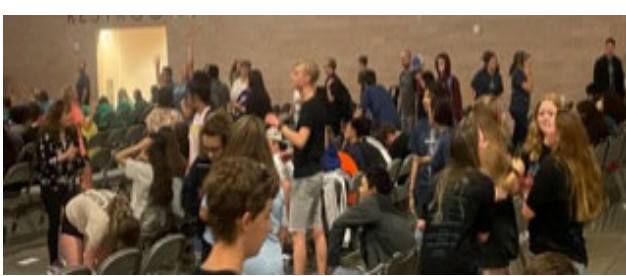
YOUTH MINISTRY

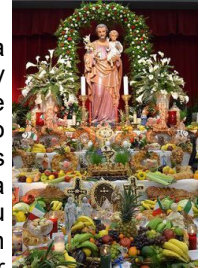

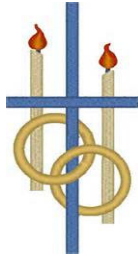
