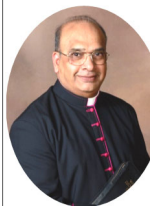

### Life: Long & Good or Eternal

Dear brothers and sisters,  
If someone asks you: How long do you want to live? Or how do you want to live? Or why do you want to live? What will be your answer?

God gave us commandments and says, "if you observe my statutes and commandments, you will live long, a good life and have eternal life - the promised land. Jesus says, "You are NOT far from the kingdom of God." For Jesus to come to the world and save us did the same thing - he laid down His life [Jn. 10:18; 1Jn.3:16] - loved God and us with all his heart, with all his mind, with all his soul, with all his strength; for us to have abundant life. [John 10:10]

A couple of years ago, Newsweek magazine ran an article on "Faith and Healing" talking about an event: A fourth-year medical student in Dallas, came across a man dying in the VA Hospital. Suffering from a rare cancer and hooked up to an oxygen tank, the man, could barely breathe, let alone speak. None of his relatives were by his bed to comfort him. When the student walked into his room, the man looked at her and said, 'Now that I'm dying, I realize that I never really learned how to live.' Did you learn to live? Learn!

"Eternal life in the future tense is eternity with God. Eternal life in the present tense is knowing God personally and loving others. We do our duty as believers, but no passion drives us; no power enables us. Sometimes our very busyness for God masks the emptiness we still experience. And we feel guilty for being Christian. As we craft our lives to know and love God and others, we move from religion to relationship, from duty to passion, from frustration to faithfulness.

It's not how long we live, but how & how good you live that makes you 'not far from God's kingdom'.
