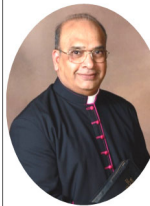

Richly Poor & Poorly Rich



Dear brothers and sisters,
 Last week, the Lord said about loving God and others with ALL our heart, mind, soul and strength. What does "ALL" mean? Until it hurts one's life, which revealed through the poor widows' giving - her last meal and her last pennies - richly poor. How?

"Blessed are the poor in spirit." [Mt. 5:3]

The rich were giving large sums (Mark 12:41), but they still retained their fortunes; the widow "put in everything - all she had to live on." (Mark 12:42) Her sacrifice was greater than the wealthy people's sacrifice. It's the matter of the heart. The women were in need of receiving charity, yet they had a heart to give. It was a negligible amount-what could a widow's mite buy or that God could use it!

A miser was approached by a community charity fund-raiser. "Sir, our records show that despite your wealth, you've never once given to our drive." The man replied, "Do your records show that I have an elderly mother who was left penniless; or that I have a disabled brother unable to work; a widowed sister with small children who can barely make ends meet?" "No, sir," replied the volunteer. "Well, I don't give to any of them, so why should I give anything to you?"

Anyone who has a loving hearts gives. You can give without loving; but you can't love without giving. Mother Theresa said, "Love until it hurts." Real love is always painful and hurts for the ones we love. It hurt the widows to give but they gave; and God blessed them.

God distributes wealth unevenly not because He loves some of His children more than others, but so His children can distribute it to their brothers and sisters on His behalf and be godly. What counts is, "How much love you put into what you do." Please read Ephesians 1:18-19 and be rich with God's blessings; and not be poorly rich.

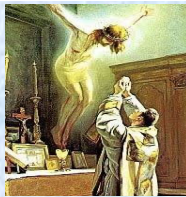

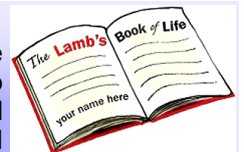
Baptismal Preparation

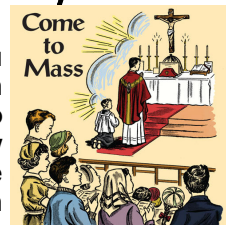

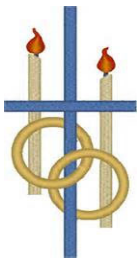
