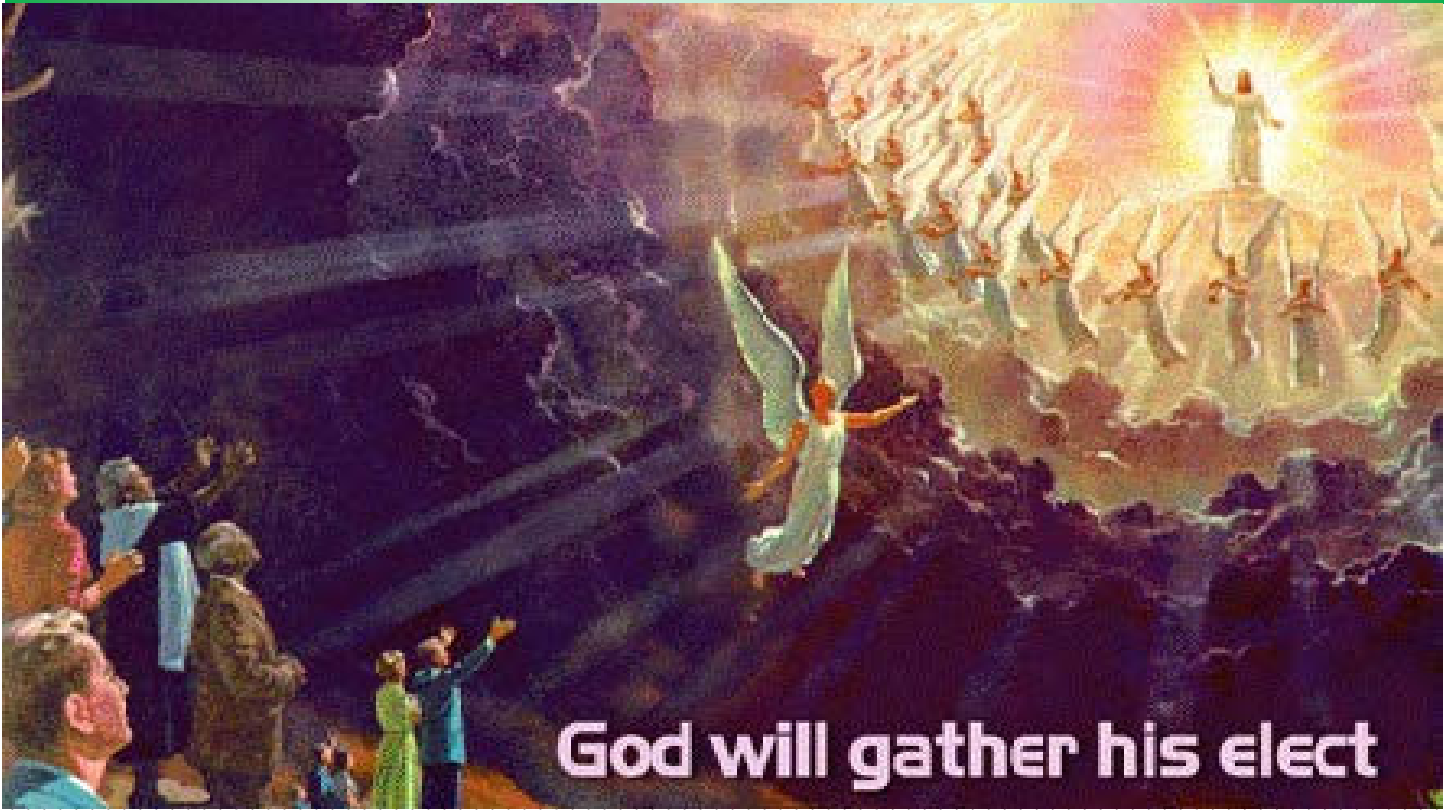

Dear brothers and sisters,
 At the closing of the Liturgical year we stand before Christ, the King [next weekend]. How? With hearts weighed down with worries of life or are you confident that you are an elect of God [1Pet. 2:9] and your name is written in the

book of Life? [Rev. 20:12]

The Prophet Daniel says, "Everyone shall awake – some to live forever; These are the wise ones – shining brightly; and those who lead many to justice shall be like stars forever. Others to be in an everlasting horror and disgrace," whose names are not written in the book of life. [Rev. 13:8; 17:8] St. Paul says, "God has chosen us from the foundation of the World." [Eph. 1:3-6] Therefore, we are chosen; and need to stand like His elect – be vigilant and pray at all times – live in the presence of God.

In boxing, when a boxer has had enough, the trainer can "throw in the towel." This signifies we just can't go on any further... We often use the turn of phrase to say we're giving up. In our Christian lives, that we feel like giving up in a particular situation. But our purpose is to stand firm, to continue fighting the good fight. Giving up is not really an option. [2 Tim. 4: 7-8]

St. Joseph was a righteous man. He stood firm in good times and in bad; in his challenging times. He never tried to do his own will but followed the will of God.



So when the devil comes and says look at your thoughts, look at your actions and ways we can still respond and say "I look to Christ, I stand in his promises, it is his rightness that covers me, first find fault in Jesus before you drive me to despair, my hope is in him". The devil will never find fault with Jesus, so be assured, stand firm and resist when the day of evil comes "For us to live is Christ!" May your life be filled with courage and confidence in God.
