## God's Chooses the Weak



Dear brothers and sisters,

All of God's Giants have been weak men. Hudson Taylor, founder of the China Inland Mission, knew the secret of strength through weakness. Complimented once by a friend on the impact of the mission, Hudson answered, "It seemed to me that God looked over the whole world to find a man who was weak enough to do His work, and when He at last found me, He said, 'He is weak enough - he'll do.' All God's giants have been weak men who did great things for God because they counted on His being with them." (Our Daily Bread)

In the readings of this week: Isaiah [unclean lips], Paul [born abnormally] and Peter [sinful man] accepted their weakness or sinfulness, not after they were chosen, but before. Yes, the bible tells of so many giants who were weak but chosen. (1 Cor. 1:26-28) But God chose them not only to make us perfect, but to perfect His power and strength. (2 Cor.12:8-10) It is not because of our 'goodness' God chose us, but because of our 'weakness' and because of His mercy. We live and move and have our being by the mercy of God! Therefore, we say, "God does not call the qualified, but qualifies the called".

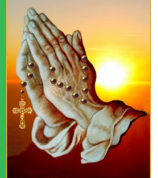
I personally feel the same way in my priestly life: born as 'unwanted child', last of my family; grew up in a unknown village; studied not in a reputed school; but the Lord chose, called, formed, educated and qualified me to serve you and uses me to accomplish much in His name.

With the synodal theme of 'communion, participation and mission', we can clearly see how God takes initiatives to be in communion with us, participates in our daily life; chooses us and empowers us for His mission – we are to catch men, save souls in our daily life beginning from our families. Let the Lord work in us and through us; and NOT our weakness. My prayers and blessings!

### THE BAPTISM OF JESUS

Sunday, January 09, the Church celebrated the **Solemnity of the Baptism of Our Lord**. This brought to an end the season of Christmas.

The Church recalled Our Lord's second manifestation or epiphany which occurred on the occasion of His baptism in the Jordan. Jesus descended into the River to sanctify its waters and to give them the power to beget sons of God. The event takes on the importance of a second creation in which the entire Trinity intervenes.

The baptism of John was a sort of sacramental preparation for the Baptism of Christ. It moved men to sentiments of repentance and induced them to confess their sins. Christ did not need the baptism of John. Although He appeared in the "substance of our flesh" and was recognized "outwardly like unto ourselves," He was absolutely sinless and impeccable. He conferred upon the water the power of the true Baptism which would remove all the sins of the world: "Behold the Lamb of God, behold Him Who takes away the sin of the world."



Many of the incidents which accompanied Christ's baptism are symbolical of what happened at our Baptism. At Christ's baptism the Holy Spirit descended upon Him; at our Baptism the Trinity took its abode in our soul. At His baptism Christ was proclaimed the "Beloved Son" of the Father; at our Baptism we become the adopted sons of God. At Christ's baptism the heavens were opened; at our Baptism heaven was opened to us. At His baptism Jesus prayed; after our Baptism we must pray to avoid actual sin.

## Wednesday Youth Ministry

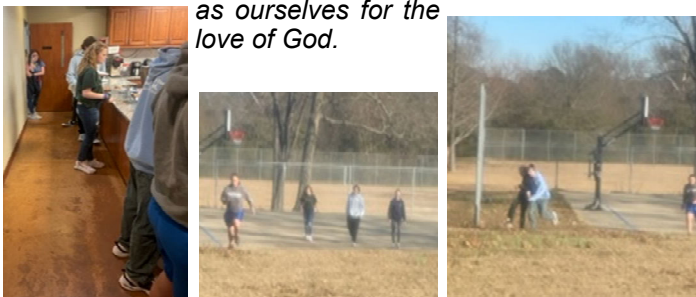

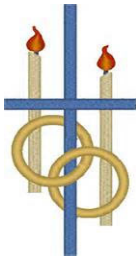
