Dear brothers and sisters,
You hear people say, "I would be a giver in life if I had something to give." Those people don't understand that giving has nothing to do with assets. You and I have only one life. And when we get to the end of our lives, the only thing that's going to count is whether we have lived for Christ - givers or takers; contributors or consumers in life.

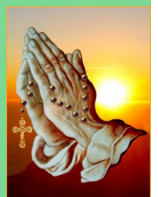

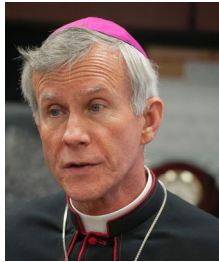

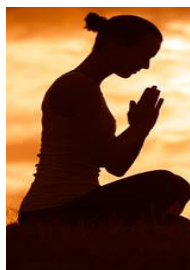

The Difference between Meditation & Contemplation

They are distinct ways of praying to God.



Meditation: The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* summarizes meditation as “a prayerful quest engaging thought, imagination, emotion, and desire. It’s goal is to make our own in faith the subject considered, by confronting it with the reality of our own life” (CCC 2723)

In meditation the “mind seeks to understand the why and how of the Christian life, in order to adhere and respond to what the Lord is asking” (CCC 2705). This helps us to discover our personal role in God’s plan.

Contemplation, on the other hand, is (in the words of St. Teresa of Avila) “nothing else than a close sharing between friends; it means taking time frequently to be alone with him who we know loves us.” The Catechism reiterates this theme when it summarizes this type of prayer. Contemplative prayer is the simple expression of the mystery of prayer. It is a gaze of faith fixed on Jesus, an attentiveness to the Word of God, a silent love. It achieves real union with the prayer of Christ to the extent that it makes us share in his mystery. (CCC 2724)

Contemplation might best be summarized by the phrase, “I look at him and he looks at me,” a description of prayer that “a certain peasant of Ars ... used to say while praying before the tabernacle” (CCC 2715). While both types of prayer foster a relationship with God, contemplation is where that love is expressed and realized; and we contemplate “Someone,” a person, God himself. Perhaps it could be put simply, meditation helps us to *know* God and contemplation helps us to *love* him.



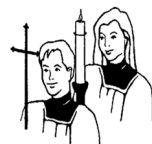

YOUTH MINISTRY

Wednesday Youth Ministry

A great group of students came to celebrate Jesus! We talked about feeling loved and how everyone should be loved. We discussed that Jesus loves us, but how do we know? We talked about loving Jesus, and what makes us love him so much. The group worked on Valentine's Day cards for our seniors in a nursing home. What better way to show our love than to those in need. You are loved beyond measure. (Romans 8:38-39)

Students are encouraged to bring a friend or two. "Two can accomplish more than twice as much as one, for the results can be much better. If one falls, the other pulls him up; but if a man falls when he is alone, he's in trouble" (Ecclesiastes 4:9) Faith formation is for all to experience and what better way than to experience it with your friends. We all need the strength that exceeds our own power, which only comes from praying with another. The more the better!

Sunday Youth Ministry

This past Sunday the topic of Healing was discussed. We opened with Genesis 3:1-7, discussed original sin and what that looks like today. We discussed things that tempt us to doubt God or not trust Him. We talked about one of the most difficult things, which is to accept faith in God's goodness because of all the evil we have in the world today. The question was posed: if God is good, why is there evil in the world? This is where God gives us the capability of free will. God's intention for the world is not evil, it is us as humans that make it that way. We are so quick to point the finger at one another or God when something does not go right in our lives. We then explained to the youth it is important to look within ourselves and evaluate us and whether we can make a difference.

Jesus is sometimes called the divine physician. We asked the youth, have you ever thought about the church as a hospital? Most everyone said no. We explained that we are all broken souls, and we all go to church seeking that healing. Whether it's through confession and meetings with your parish priest, we all are striving to be better.

Jesus is the best physician because he will never leave us and he knows what we need. Sin can be like slavery, meaning it can become habitual. A weakened will finds it difficult to choose the good. Turn to Jesus as he is there to heal us.

Virtue of the week: Compassion - The strength to be aware of the needs of others and the desire to help them.

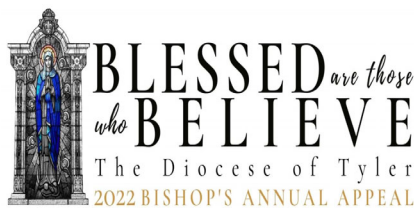
