## Living Liturgically in Lent



Dear brothers and sisters,

We have begun another Lenten season within the Year of the Family. Our notion is of "giving something up," but I would guide you to live it liturgically. In addition to giving something up, look for ways to live Lent as you go about your day. Here are a

few ideas:

**At home:** Many of you may have the decorations in your home that feel intimate – in the living, dining, bed and bath rooms. During Lent, remove them or put a simple dried stem in a vase. This is a tangible & daily reminder of the suffering of Christ; a season of penance, sorrow and death. By seeing empty vases or dried stems, you will nudge yourself to unite with the sufferings of Christ. At Easter, you may change them to fresh flowers, etc.

**At Church:** Lent is the best time for us to frequent the sacraments - Confession & Eucharist. "In the confession, the sinner, placing him/herself before the merciful judgment of God, anticipates in a certain way the judgment to which he will be subjected at the end of his earthly life." (CCC 1470) Jesus speaks to us from the cross, "Father, forgive them." Or "40 days Eucharist" with daily Mass and Holy Communion will be another practice.

**Private:** Daily prayer is the bastion of Christian life. Accept the gentle invitation to the desert, where Jesus is waiting. This will likely look different for each one of us. Start the day in prayer; the morning commute, meal preparation, lunch breaks, and so on. Perhaps, swap the podcast or phone call for a few minutes of silence. Have the desert experience with Christ. He is waiting!

**A Companion:** We are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses ..." (Hebrews 12:1) Let a favorite saint accompany you to Calvary. All the saints walked with Jesus through the "desert experience." It is good to accept a divine aid which should assist us to Rise with Christ Jesus. Let us take a step forward, today.

## Fasting & Abstinence

- **Fasting** is defined as having one full meal a day, and is required only on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This requirement is for ages 18 to 59, but younger and older may participate.
  - **During Lent** abstinence from meat on Fridays is obligatory in the United States, as elsewhere, for all Catholics age 14 until death.
- Fasting is meaningless unless our hearts fast from obstacles blocking our way to true discipleship.

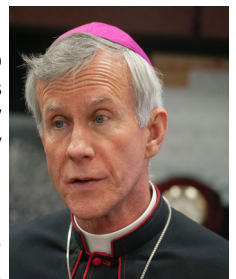

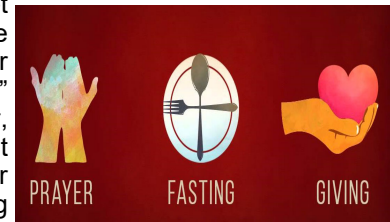

### A Few Easy Lenten Traditions For Families:

1. Go to Mass as a family on Ash Wednesday. This is so great because even the smallest members of the family can have ashes.
2. Read the scripture about when Jesus goes into the desert.
3. Motivate your children to do good deeds and make sacrifices. We often do the crown of thorns, but a sacrifice jar with beans is easier to set up.
4. Give something up for Lent as a family, even if you kids are young enough that you don't "have" to. We always give up candy as a blanket sacrifice, and then decide on other things. Other good "blanket sacrifices" are no music in the car, no eating out, silent "monastery" lunches, or drinking only water during Lent, etc.
5. Set up an almsgiving box – you simply set out a box, and take 1 thing from your own pantry every day of Lent. At the end of Lent, take the box to a food pantry.
6. Set up an offering jar– all you need is a jar or piggy bank of some kind. Spare change goes into the jar for the length of Lent, and then is donated.
7. Attend stations of the cross at your church.
8. Cook simple meatless meals together with your kids. This will be a good sacrifice opportunity for you.
9. Lenten cleaning – rather than the idea of "Spring cleaning", clean 1 area of your home every day during Lent. Your house is beautiful and clean for Easter!
10. Read 1 Saint story per day.
11. Read the Bible together as a family daily. This can be done in the morning at breakfast, and doesn't have to take long. You can just read a paragraph each day.



There are many more you could do.  
 May the Lenten days bring your families together.

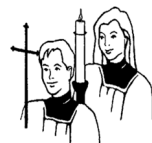

## DURING LENT:

### How to start talking to God?

The Catechism of the Catholic Church lays this out perfectly saying, "Whether we realize it or not, prayer is the encounter of God's thirst with ours. God thirsts that we may thirst for him" (CCC 2560). It doesn't matter who we are, where we are, or what we've done: God is there, waiting for us to come before Him in humble surrender, and it's His desire, His thirst for us, that makes it possible for us to desire Him.

Prayer is "God's business. You bring yourself in whatever state you are and offer that to God. I was having trouble with prayer because my prayers were a monologue, not a dialogue. I wasn't listening to what God was saying to me!

It doesn't matter if you say the perfect prayer or are in the holiest state. What matters most is giving time to God, simply placing yourself in His presence. He wants to encounter us, and we need to encounter Him authentically if we're going to survive as Christians.

That being said, I want to give you a few practical tips that have helped me encounter God in my life: 1. Praying with Scripture. How?

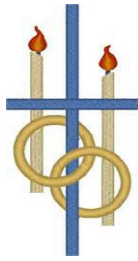
