## Something New Everyday



Dear brothers and sisters,

A couple was celebrating 50 years of marriage. Someone commented, "Ken, 50 years is a long time." He immediately responded: "Not nearly as long as it would have been without her." The man couldn't get the husband's answer out of his mind. All day long he kept thinking, "not nearly as long as it would have been without her." Finally, he found himself starting to write about his life with his wife and the conclusion that all I really want from her is: Just one more day!"

God continues to give "one more day" every day. So that He can make something new in us and for us. God's presence in a human life automatically creates new possibilities and choices. For Israel, the choice was one of freedom in a covenantal relationship of limitless possibilities.

For the accused woman, the choice was one of a new integrity created by Jesus' healing forgiveness. He gave her a new life; and new beginning. The Pharisees were offered the possibility of perceiving themselves and God in a new light – their conscience renewed and revived to a new way of life. (Gospel). In order to choose responsibly and answer life's God-given possibilities, we must be daily formed by faith into the pattern of Christ's dying and rising. How do we do it? It's very easy!

As Christians, we are spiritually wired for compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, patience, and love. (Colossians 3:12, 14) Those qualities should be delicious to us. They should feel like they "fit" us when we put them on. We should respect them, desire them, and feel most alive when we exhibit them. It's a good day if we demonstrated compassion, displayed kindness, walked in humility, treated others with gentleness and patience, and took the opportunity to love others as much as was possible.

The two most engaging powers of an author / God are to make new things familiar and familiar things new. But He expects us to do it! Blessings! Msgr. Xavier

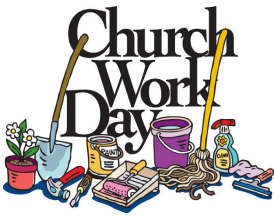

### A Few Easy Lenten Traditions For Families:

1. Go to Mass as a family on Ash Wednesday. This is so great because even the smallest members of the family can have ashes.
  2. Read the scripture about when Jesus goes into the desert.
  3. Motivate your children to do good deeds and make sacrifices. We often do the crown of thorns, but a sacrifice jar with beans is easier to set up.
  4. Give something up for Lent as a family, even if you kids are young enough that you don't "have" to. We always give up candy as a blanket sacrifice, and then decide on other things. Other good "blanket sacrifices" are no music in the car, no eating out, silent "monastery" lunches, or drinking only water during Lent, etc.
  5. Set up an almsgiving box – you simply set out a box, and take 1 thing from your own pantry every day of Lent. At the end of Lent, take the box to a food pantry.
  6. Set up an offering jar– all you need is a jar or piggy bank of some kind. Spare change goes into the jar for the length of Lent, and then is donated.
  7. Attend stations of the cross at your church.
  8. Cook simple meatless meals together with your kids. This will be a good sacrifice opportunity for you.
  9. Lenten cleaning – rather than the idea of "Spring cleaning", clean 1 area of your home every day during Lent. Your house is beautiful and clean for Easter!
  10. Read 1 Saint story per day.
  11. Read the Bible together as a family daily. This can be done in the morning at breakfast, and doesn't have to take long. You can just read a paragraph each day.
- There are many more you could do.  
May the Lenten days bring your families together.

This week the topic of **Criticism** was discussed. The initial conversation with our youth was what does it mean to them? Most of them saw it as a negative. Some understood the aspect of constructive criticism.

In this age of social media, we are so quick to engage in an argument with someone if they disagree or offer criticism. Why is that? Well as human beings the initial response is to be defensive and want to fight back.

But is this the proper response? No, we explained to the youth, take a step back and analyze what that person has said. Is it true? Can we learn from it? If it is true, then where does that leave you. You have no reason to argue at that point. Take the criticism and learn from it. If the criticism does not apply to you at all as a person, then let it roll off you. Do not dwell on something that doesn't pertain to you as a person.

My favorite Bible verse regarding this subject is *James 5:9. Do not grumble against one another, brothers, so that you may not be judged: behold the Judge is standing at the door.* What we can take from this is the only opinion that matters are Gods. So, learn from this Brothers and Sisters and realize that you are created in his image and are unique. Criticism does not take away from who you are as a person. After all we are created in his image. Do not dwell on the negative but instead make it a positive if possible and let it make you better as a person if it pertains to you. God Bless

## DURING LENT: How to start talking to God?

### Run to the Sacraments

The sacraments are what set Catholics apart from every other world religion. As Catholics, we don't have to have a purely spiritual experience to receive and draw near to God. No, in the sacraments, God draws us near to Him. He does most of the work! Again, all we have to do is place ourselves in His presence and be open to receiving Him.

I have heard from countless converts that just hearing the words, "I absolve you from your sins" in the Sacrament of Reconciliation is a remarkable source of solace and calm. This rings true for me, a cradle Catholic, as well.

To prove His love for us, Christ gave us the Eucharist, a gift unlike any other. He gave us His Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity to transform us. Frequent reception of the Eucharist and the other sacraments keeps us united to the Lord.

In my life, the further I've drifted away from the sacraments, the weaker my faith has become. Run to the sacraments always, and make sure they are the foundation of your faith — not your feelings or another person, but the sacraments.

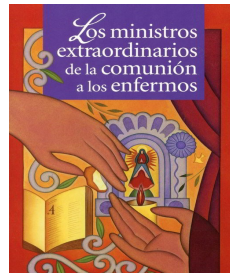

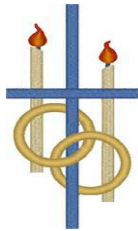
