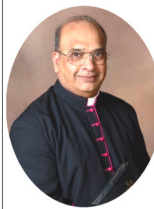

## Families: Agents of Divine Mercy

Dear brothers and sisters,

I wish you and your family the blessings of peace and mercy of the Risen Lord. Let us live in this peace and joy. Do not return to "life as usual" - living as if the Lord had not died for us; as if he did not rise from the dead; as if he did not forgive and show His mercy. But as if He lives with us as He appeared to His disciples at the sea of Tiberius and Galilee.

In the world that, "permits everything and forgives nothing" we are encouraged to live as "agents of mercy." What is mercy? Mercy is the source of forgiveness; and forgiveness is the expression of mercy. Mercy is not just a feeling of compassion, but doing something to help. Remember the Good Samaritan story; being a neighbor. The merciful person is the one who remembers their own sin, and how God forgave him/her, and understands the weakness of others and forgives them.

Abraham was merciful to Lot; Joseph was merciful to his brothers; David was merciful to Saul; Moses was merciful to Miriam; and so on and so on. They were aware that they were chosen to be agents of mercy. Jesus was merciful to all.

In our families, everyone has to deal with people who are just down-right peculiar: Husbands and wives know from experience how important it is to share God's love & mercy with each other, and with their children. The family is a school of love, a school wherein young people learn how to give of themselves to others and where they learn how to be forgiven and to forgive in turn.

Failure to extend this mercy in our families, leads to misery. [Prov. 11:17; Mt. 18: 33-35] How do we respond in our families? 3 responses: **I can't or I won't or I will.** You and your family can be the agents of mercy. This experience or learning extends to others by your daily living. Be an agent of mercy beginning from your family.

### **Child Abuse Prevention Month**

Every April, child and youth serving organizations, including Catholic dioceses, parishes, and schools, participate in National Child Abuse Prevention Month to highlight the importance of protecting minors from abuse. These efforts are part of the ongoing work of the Church in the United States.

- The child shows sudden changes in behavior or school performance.
- The child is always watchful as though preparing for something bad to happen.
- The child has not received help for medical problems brought to parents' attention.
- The child has learning problems that cannot be attributed to specific physical or psychological causes.
- The child is overly compliant, passive or withdrawn. The child lacks adult supervision.

### EASTER SYMBOLS & TRADITIONS:

#### Easter Bunny:

According to some sources, the Easter bunny first arrived in America in the 1700s with German immigrants who settled in Pennsylvania and transported their tradition of an egg-laying hare called "Osterhase" or "Oschter Haws." Their children made nests in which this creature could lay its colored eggs. Eventually, the custom spread across the U.S. and the fabled rabbit's Easter morning deliveries expanded to include chocolate and other types of candy and gifts, while decorated baskets replaced nests.

#### Easter Egg:

The egg, an ancient symbol of new life, has been associated with pagan festivals celebrating spring. From a Christian perspective, Easter eggs are said to represent Jesus' emergence from the tomb and resurrection. Decorating eggs for Easter is a tradition that dates back to at least the 13th century, according to some sources. Easter egg hunts and egg rolling are two popular egg-related traditions. The event has no religious significance, although some people have considered egg rolling symbolic of the stone blocking Jesus' tomb being rolled away, leading to his resurrection.

#### Lamb and Traditional Easter Foods

Lamb is a traditional Easter food. Christians refer to Jesus as the "Lamb of God," though lamb at Easter also has roots in early Passover celebrations. In the story of Exodus, the people of Egypt suffered a series of terrible plagues, including the death of all firstborn sons. Members of the Jewish faith painted their doorposts with sacrificed lamb's blood so that God would "pass over" their homes. Jews who converted to Christianity continued the tradition of eating lamb at Easter. Historically, lamb would have been one of the first fresh meats available after a long winter with no livestock to slaughter.

#### Easter Lilies

White Easter Lilies symbolize the purity of Christ to Christians and are common decorations in churches and homes around the Easter holiday. Their growth from dormant bulbs in the ground to flowers symbolize the rebirth and hope of Christ's resurrection. They become the unofficial flower of Easter celebrations across the United States.

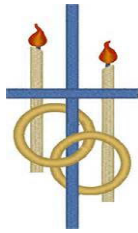
