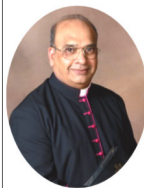

Listening to the Holy Spirit



Dear brothers and sisters,
How well do you listen to the Holy Spirit? If you don't listen to Him, you'll have major problems in life. Therefore, the Father God tells us "listen to Jesus, His Son." Jesus listened to His Father day and night.

Through out His life, Jesus tells us, "He who has ears, let him hear." [Mt.11:15, 13:9; 13:43 and many more] Even after His Ascension, He told us to cultivate "hearing ears." [Rev. 2: 7,11; 17: 7,29 and more] Why? It is totally important for a believer to listen to oneself, to others and to God. Not listening messes up our living.

Ben was not born with listening ability; but now he had a special knack of listening. His brother and sister were born deaf mutes, so from childhood he had to learn their sign language. To do this one must be very attentive to every move of the hands and fingers... and of course one never says anything. Only watching constantly and attentively, giving all one's attention to the speaker. This trained Ben more than anything else, to do the same when others spoke vocally.

When you are able to be still you will be able to listen to the Holy Spirit. "Be still and know that I'm God." Psalm 46:10 "having heard the Word and keep it..." [Lk.8:15] How? Develop: 1) an attitude of "a lot to learn" and "a lot of I DON'T KNOW"; 2) a good heart to do good to others; 3) listen to His word that helps you to learn, for reproof, for correction, for instruction...[2 Tim. 3:16] It is profitable listening.

Listening is a relationship. You invest time in your relationship when you listen - with God and with one another. Moses listened and lead the people; Elijah listened to God in a "still small voice." Paul listened only when there was flashing light and a loud voice. How and when will you listen? Take some quiet time day and night to listen to the Holy Spirit that is in you to build a relationship with God and others.

Pro-Life: Fetal Development, Month 2

The developing baby is now called a "fetus", which is Latin for "little one". She is making rapid progress developing all her external and internal organs. During the second month baby teeth form, and fingers and toes are developing. Her ears, nose, lips and tongue can now be seen. Brain waves can be recorded. The skeleton changes from cartilage to bone. The central nervous system is now functioning, and so forty muscle sets begin their first exercises. By 8 weeks all body systems are present. This little one can now suck her thumb.

Learn the Signs of Child Abuse

- The child has learning problems that cannot be attributed to specific physical or psychological causes.
- The child is overly compliant, passive or withdrawn. The child lacks adult supervision.

Sunday Youth Ministry

Last time we discussed *What is your Vocation?* We started with the youth's perception of the word vocation. Some of which included God's plan for my future which is true. We explained that vocation has basically 3 senses of the word.

1. Call to Holiness or Sainthood
2. Determining your calling, whether it is as a priest, nun, religious occupation, marriage, or single.
3. And finally, our day-to-day tasks

Call to holiness never changes. That is our vocation throughout our lives. The second sense can change but not as frequent as number 3. Our day-to-day tasks can dictate what happens in determining your calling. For instance, when you are graduating high school and are single and entering the workforce, your day-to-day tasks would differ from someone that is married and has children. When growing I explained to the kids that when we heard the word Vocation it meant are you going to be a priest, nun, or enter some type of religious work. We explained that the most important thing you can do with your vocation is remember first and foremost put God first in everything you do and continue that journey toward Holiness. Pray for discernment in determining your calling as an occupation and remember your day-to-day tasks will change throughout your life.

Virtue of the week: Honesty - The strength to tell the truth even when it would be easier to lie.

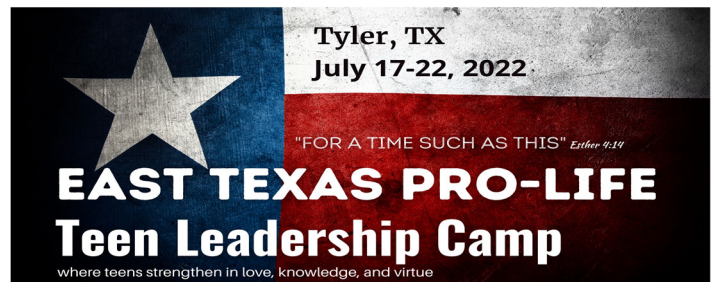

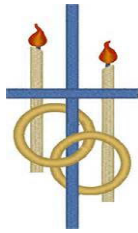
