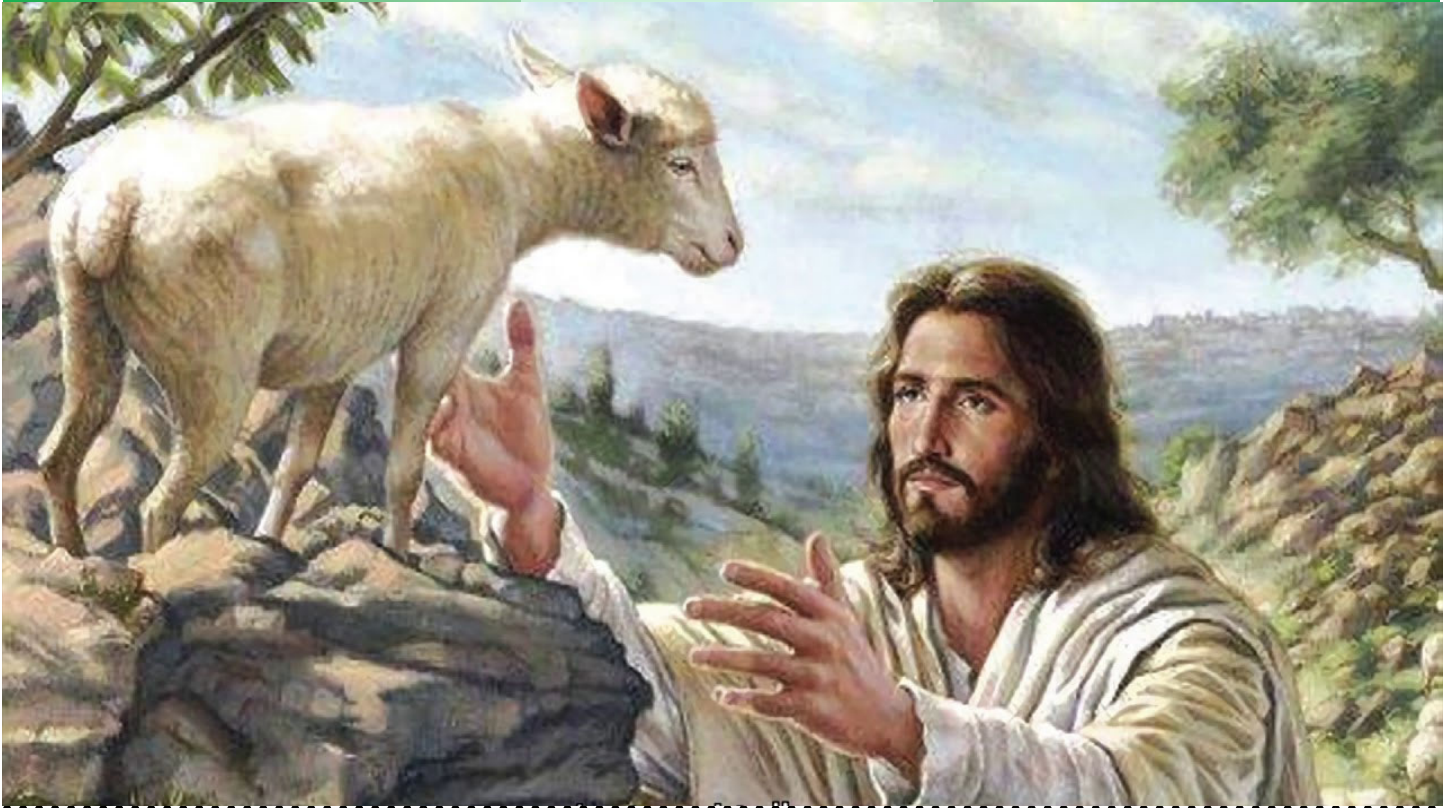

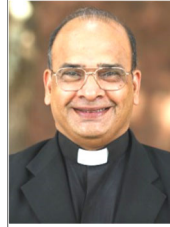

Dear brothers and sisters,  
 A young man was undisciplined, and refused to listen to his parents. His mother had made it a rule that she "would not retire, go to bed, until he came home." That was her rule. She said, if he did not come home until five o'clock in the morning, I sat up, and when he was out all night I got no sleep; but when he came home I always met him with a kiss. I threw my arms around his neck. I treated him just as if he was kind and good. Sometimes he would be out all night. Those nights I would not go to bed. He used to know it."

"One night he came home. I looked to see if he was under the influence of liquor. He came up to me, and he said, 'Mother, I have been converted,' and then I fell on his neck and embraced him, and wept over him tears of joy. You don't know what a load it took off my heart. I praised God that my prayers had been answered."

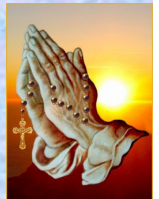
When we search and seek for a lost thing and a lost animal, the Lord "waits" for you and me to come back. We might be dissipated from God, "No matter how many steps we take away from Jesus, it only takes one step to get back, and He comes running." He changes his mind from punishing us [Ex.32:14], when we change our ways & return to Him. No questions asked; just his return is celebrated.

Like the prodigal son and the pouting son, we abuse God's grace. We have a loving family, father, mother, a good home, provision, a future, and an inheritance, but we trade it all in for temporal pleasures / selfishness. By asking his inheritance that he would get after his father's death, he literally killed his father. The father gave him / us His inheritance / grace. He is not going to take away our "free-will." Therefore, always count on God's kindness and take the first step towards Him, He will run to us and celebrate with us.

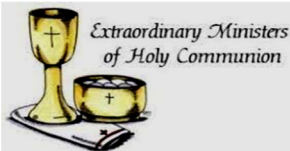

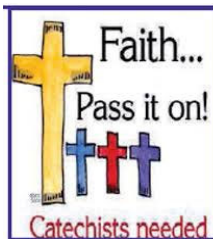

### **Why are Youth Programs Important?**

Youth programs offer huge benefits to tweens and teens. Researchers refer to the Six C's - desired outcomes that many youth programs provide to young people:



1. Competence in academic, social, and vocational areas.
2. Confidence or a positive self-identity.
3. Connections to community, family, and peers.
4. Character or positive values, integrity, and moral commitment.
5. Caring and compassion.
6. Contribution.

As children grow to middle and high school age, they seek more autonomy and independence. They naturally react against authority and the kinds of structure found in programs for younger children. Not surprisingly, these youth program qualities benefit teens developmentally. Youth programs are important because they can help build these Six C's, preparing adolescents for a variety of roles they assume as they reach college-age and the workforce.

What tweens and teens learn in youth programs can help them develop better social skills, become leaders, gain greater knowledge of themselves, and foster lifelong relationships.

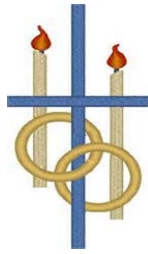
