Increasing Your Faith



Dear brothers and sisters,
The apostles asked the Lord to increase their faith. Does God increase the faith or do we need to increase it? God gives opportunities to increase our faith; we need to increase it. Practical steps to increase your faith are:

Hear God's Word: Faith comes from what is heard / by hearing the word of God. Rom.10:17. The more you hear God's word the more your faith keeps on growing as it will cause you to stay focused on the word.

Read and Meditate on His Word: Everything about life is detailed in the bible. Meditating on God's word gives you insight; and helps grow your faith. (Joshua 1:8) In Ps 119:103, How sweet are Your words to my taste, Sweeter than honey to my mouth! Ps 119:105, Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

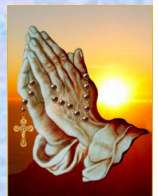
Spend Time with God: The more you spend time with God, the more your faith will grow as you get to know Him better and understand His ways. Jesus spent so much time in prayer. He prayed at night and early dawn. Mk. 1:35; Mt. 14:23. When you spend time with God you'll know how perfectly He loves you.

Exercise your Faith: Act on the word of God. For example, the word of God says; you will lay hands on the sick and they will recover, act on this word. The more you use your faith the more you grow. (James 1:22-24) Remember, "If you don't use it, you lose it".

Spread The Word: Reach out to others with the gospel of Jesus Christ. Share with people of no faith at all. God confirms His word, it grows your faith. (Mark 6:20) And they went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and confirming the word through the accompanying signs. 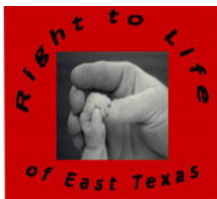

Why are Youth Programs Important?

Youth programs offer huge benefits to tweens and teens. Researchers refer to the Six C's - desired outcomes that many youth programs provide to young people:

1. Competence in academic, social, & vocational areas.
2. Confidence or a positive self-identity.
3. Connections to community, family, and peers.
4. Character or positive values, integrity, and moral commitment.
5. Caring and compassion.
6. Contribution.

As children grow to middle and high school age, they seek more autonomy and independence. They naturally react against authority and the kinds of structure found in programs for younger children. Not surprisingly, these youth program qualities benefit teens developmentally.

Youth programs are important because they can help build these Six C's, preparing adolescents for a variety of roles they assume as they reach college-age and the workforce.

What tweens & teens learn in youth programs can help them develop better social skills, become leaders, gain greater knowledge of themselves, & foster lifelong relationships. Source: <https://www.rootsofaction.com/youth-programs/>

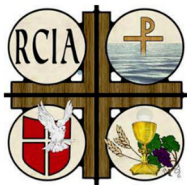

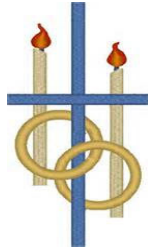
