Dynamic Faith vs Dead Faith

Dear brothers and sisters,
 Charles Blondin (1824–1897), was the great French tightrope walker. While performing on a cable across Niagara Falls, he asked his audience, "How many believe I can walk across this tightrope pushing a wheelbarrow?" The people cheered loudly. "How many believe I can push the wheelbarrow across the cable with a man in it?" Again, the people cheered. Blondin then pointed to one of the most enthusiastic men in the audience, and, said, "You're my man, now get into the wheelbarrow!" Needless to say, the man made a quick exit. We have faith but when challenged we walk away!

Faith is a fundamental doctrine in all the religions of the world, much more for Christians. The believer must walk by faith; and without faith it is impossible to please God.

Dead Faith (Demonic faith): Faith is 'dead' when 'words' are used as a substitute for 'works.' (James 2:14-17) Faith is 'dead' when 'knowledge' is not accompanied by works. When you have knowledge of the Sacred Scriptures but do not practice them, it is dead. (James 2:19) Demons also believe in the existence of God, the identity of Jesus Christ, existence of hell, etc. This is demonic faith.

Living Faith (Dynamic Faith): is based on the word of God. The 10 lepers obeyed the words of Jesus; it touched the mind, emotions and the will and moves into action (saving faith); but only one understood the truth and the power; he came back to thank the Lord (dynamic faith.) The Samaritan grew from 'dead/no faith' to 'saving faith' and to 'dynamic faith.' Naaman's faith was on the prophet's touch, not on God's word. When he humbled himself and obeyed the prophet's word, he was healed of his leprosy.

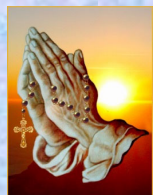

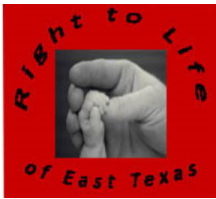

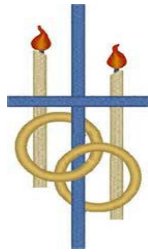
