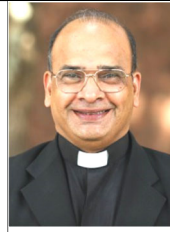

Assist to Persist in Faith

Dear brothers and sisters,
Our life is full battles to win. But we are not alone. [Ex. 33:14] God promised to be with us always, [Mt.28: 20;10:19; Lk. 12:11; Mk. 13:11] which means – we have God, our family, our Church, our friends, and the Holy Spirit to guide us what to say or do.

Israelites [God's people] facing a battle; Joshua to fight; Moses would pray for victory standing on top of the hill with the staff of God held up; when his hands raised up, the Israelites prevailed; but whenever he was tired and weary and lowered his hands, the enemies prevailed. Aaron [the priest] and Hur [family, Moses' brother-in-law] took a stone and put it for Moses to sit and then they both held up Moses' hands until sunset so Israel would prevail.

Each fought their own battles: Joshua fought the physical battle; Moses fought the intellectual, emotional, and spiritual one holding up that staff, which released spiritual power from heaven, and gave the Israelites the power to fight and win. Each did their parts to win the battle.

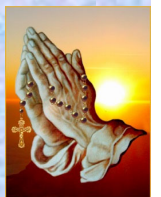
In the Gospel, the widow persisted in her request for justice; the unjust judge gave a just decision. Often the battle is long and hard. Overcoming a besetting sin in our life can take many years of struggle. It is easy to give up and let our arms droop. [2Cor. 10:4-6] There is a necessity for us to pray always without becoming weary.

Every Joshua needs a Moses; and every Moses needs an Aaron and Hur. If you know a Moses, be an Aaron and a Hur; or are you going to be an Amalek? When you fail to help lift up the arms of a Moses, a figurative way, you are contributing to the battle.

What battlegrounds are we fighting on? Are our arms flagging? Who is supporting us? Who are our Aaron and Hur? Ours may be nearby us like they were alongside Moses; or they may be at a distance, as they were for Joshua in the heat of the battle. Persist in prayer and assist one another. Prayers & Blessings! *Msgr. Xavier*

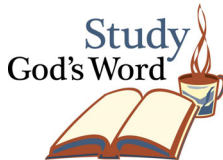

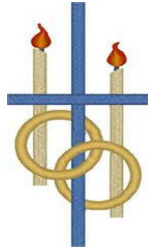
