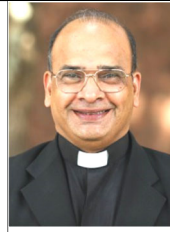

Piercing Prayers

Dear brothers and sisters,
 We admire humble people and even praise them, because they impress or live in our hearts. Therefore, humility is not weakness; it is meekness & strength. The Word guides us to reflect on our heart-prayers

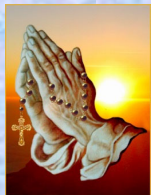
Proud Piercing: The proud people are pharisaic: they call themselves upright, spotless, sinless, very religious, dressing well to impress people, etc. They 'take their position' for all to see and to be noticed. They speak to themselves, about themselves, exalt themselves before God and condemn others around them who are no good at all. God is nowhere in their life. They "place themselves" before God / others; and 'pierce their life & others.' In short, they are narcissistic. They pray, "through your fault, through your fault, through your most grievous fault." The pharisee's prayer is in this Sunday's Gospel.

Cloud Piercing: In contrast, the Tax collectors are known and called as sinners, humble themselves before God. But he acknowledged his unworthiness / sinfulness. Lam.3:44 says, "God has covered Himself with a cloud so that no prayers can pass through." Only the prayers of the defenseless - the poor, the widow and the orphan who make God their help, refuge and strength; and the prayer of the diligent servants - those who keep God's commandments without compromise like Abraham, Moses, Job, the prophets and so on. The prayer of the humble people pierces through the clouds. They pray, "though my fault, through my fault, through my most grievous fault".

Prayers said from the heart are humble and from the head are proud. God resists the proud and gives grace to the humble. (James 4:6) St. Paul calls himself – least of the apostles (1Cor. 15:9); foremost sinner (1Tim.1:15). Always remember, "Pride is your greatest enemy; humility is your greatest friend." As Peter says (1Pet. 5:6) let us humble ourselves under the mighty hand of God; He will exalt you. Prayers & Blessings! Msgr. Xavier

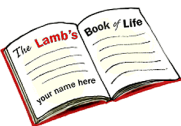

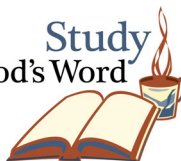
THE BOOK OF LIFE

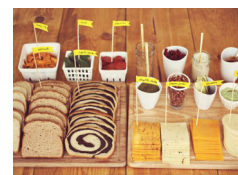

Beginning this month the baby uses all four senses. His eyelids open and close, and the eyes look around. The baby can hear, taste, touch, cough, yawn and hiccup. He now recognizes his own mother's voice. His grip is even stronger now as it will be after his birth. The hair on his head is growing longer and the downy covering on the rest of his body is disappearing. During this time the baby will receive antibodies from his mother providing him immunity to a wide variety of diseases.

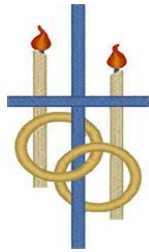
