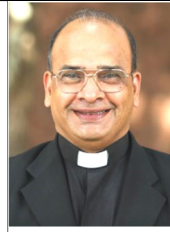

Our Stature [Status] Vs Our Nature

Dear brothers and sisters, Chris Parkening, the guitarist, traveled across the world playing beautiful music. By the age of 30, having achieved all the musical success, he felt empty. He was tired of touring and wanted to take a break; he decided to move to Montana and took up fly-fishing as a hobby. Soon he became also a world-class fly-fisherman, with all the money and time he could ever want. Despite all his success, his life was empty. He began to wonder if anything could fulfill the deep longings of his heart. While visiting friends, he attended church. During the service, Parkening was struck by 1 Cor.10:31 "Whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God." He explains, I am playing the guitar today absolutely by the grace of God. . . . My life has purpose. . . . I've learned first-hand the true secret of genuine happiness."

It goes well with Zacchaeus - as a chief tax collector, made lots of money [may not be in the right way]; he was small in stature and in spirit. He felt empty in his life after all his success. He had the curiosity – desired and determined to see Jesus; overcame his obstacles – the crowd, status, his stature – climbed a tree. When he gave up his status, weakness and sinfulness, Jesus pauses for him, gives him a personal call by name, "Zacchaeus, come down quickly, for today I must stay at your house." He responded; and it changed his nature.

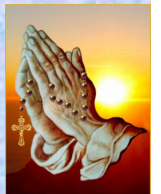
If we focus on our success or disabilities, we would never see Jesus; nor solve our problems. We must forget about our problems and desire to see Him, whether it be climbing a tree or over the pews! Let none block or distract you. Allow Jesus to come in and have dinner with you and be your closest friend. He sees not your status or stature, but your nature - desiring to see Jesus. Have your hunger be satisfied by Jesus! "A good meal ought to begin with hunger" right?

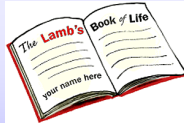

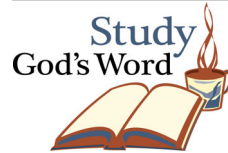

body is disappearing. During this time the baby will receive
antibodies from his mother providing him immunity to a wide
variety of diseases.

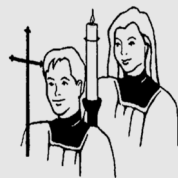
