**The Glory of God is WE Live Fully**

Dear brothers and sisters,  
St. Irenaeus says, "The glory of God is man fully alive." This could be said, "When man is fully living, he gives glory to God." For this reason, God, who cannot be grasped, comprehended or seen, allows himself to be seen, experienced and grasped by men, so that men may receive life to give glory to God.

Moses says, "On that day we shall see, for God will speak to man, and man will live." [Deut. 5:24] Jesus says, "No man has ever seen God, except the only-begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father; he has revealed him." [Jn.1:18] The Son chooses to reveal God.... [Lk.10: 22] to the one who thirsts. The thirst is nothing but living the life to glorify God. "To the thirsty I will give freely from the spring of the water of life." [Rev. 21:6] The creation gives glory to Him [Psalm 19] Are we exempted?

"If you don't see the greatness of God, then all the things that money can buy become very enticing. If you can't see the sun, you will be impressed with a street light. If you've never felt thunder and lightning, you'll be impressed with fireworks. And, if you turn your back on the greatness and majesty of God, you'll fall in love with a world of shadows and short-lived pleasures." (John Piper)

This weekend, the readings encourage us to live to glorify God – the mother encourages all her sons to die or be martyred glorifying God that they be resurrected. [2 Mac.7] Their purpose of death is to glorify God; because 'God is a God of the living not of the dead.' They wanted to live in God. If we are just existing, and not living, we are already dead. Wake up and see the glory of God!

Every tree points toward heaven; every bird has a song to sing; even every moment of wind goes in some direction. There is nothing chaotic about our beautifully designed world. All creation has a message to tell. It says, "Listen, there is a God. He crowned you with glory & honor!" (Psalm 8) Live it! Prayers & Blessings! Msgr. Xavier

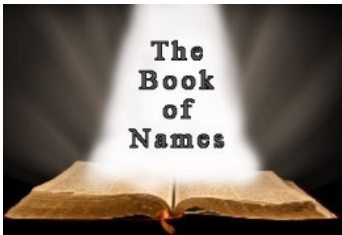

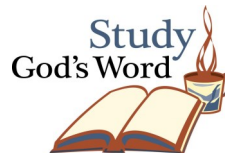

### What is a saint in the Catholic Church?

A canonized saint in the Catholic Church is a person who is officially recognized as having lived a life of **heroic virtue** while on earth.

The word itself is derived from the Latin word *sanctus* meaning "holy," and in general refers to **all the faithful who strive after a life of holiness**. It refers to those men and women who lead exemplary lives of holiness. They were NOT perfect, but strived to glorify God in the daily life with their "heroic" virtues. They always got-up when they fell in the sins.

### What is Purgatory?

Purgatory is that state in which people who have died in God's Grace, but have not let go of some of the imperfections and attachments of sin, go through a purification before entering Heaven, where nothing unclean may enter.

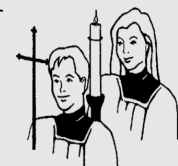
