End of Time: Accept or Ignore!

Dear brothers and sisters,
We are coming to the end of the Liturgical year. The readings lead us to reflect on our end of time. Do we ignore it or pay attention? Ignoring it does nothing to help us to be ready for Christ's return; and that some signs are foretold to let us know that we are to prepare. We can't ignore it, because it is the Word of God. We also can't be over reactive to it.

What do these dates have in common (1248, 1306, 1689, 1792, 1836, 1844, 1914, 1936, 1960, 1974, 1981, 1988, 1989, 1992, 1994, 2011)? They all represent the times in which people predicted that the second coming of Christ would occur. No one, not even Jesus knows the exact time of Christ's coming. (Mt. 24:36) How are we to take it? Stand firm!

The Bible does not give us this information but it gives us signs to look for – wars [so many wars, now in Ukraine] which threatens the world to another world war! The earthquakes, famines, floods, COVID, etc. happen. How are we to take it? Don't worry! Don't fear! But watch that you are not deceived by false doctrines, teachers, religion and messiahs.

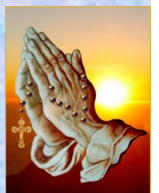
Someone said, "The study of the end times is like golf, it's fun, it gives you something to do, but in the long run you end up arriving at the same place you left from." In the fall, we see the trees shed their dried leaves; and in the spring it brings forth the leave again, we continue to live our life. How? Jesus says, stand firm and pray to win life; so that we would be ready, when the Lord comes, to experience the resurrection of the dead. St. Peter has said it well in 2 Peter 3:8-10.

We Catholics have a great resource to prepare ourselves for the end of time through the sacraments, which give us needed grace and the essential element of Christ's redemption of the world. Therefore, stand firm!

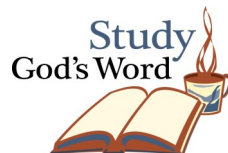


Year-End Contribution:

What is a saint in the Catholic Church?

A canonized saint in the Catholic Church is a person who is officially recognized as having lived a life of **heroic virtue** while on earth.

The word itself is derived from the Latin word *sanctus* meaning "holy," and in general refers to **all the faithful who strive after a life of holiness**. It refers to those men and women who lead exemplary lives of holiness. They were NOT perfect, but strived to glorify God in the daily life with their "heroic" virtues. They always got-up when they fell in the sins.

What is Purgatory?

Purgatory is that state in which people who have died in God's Grace, but have not let go of some of the imperfections and attachments of sin, go through a purification before entering Heaven, where nothing unclean may enter.
