## God-with-Us or Us-with-God

Dear brothers and sisters,  
 I wish you and your family a Joyous Christmas. May Jesus Christ who is born for us be with you; May you see this God-child filling your hearts and homes with His peace and Joy.

In the Child of Bethlehem, the 'smallness' of God-made-man reveals to us the greatness of man and the beauty of our dignity as children of God. Contemplating this Child, 'God-with-us', we see how great is the faith that God places in each of us, and how great is the chance given us to do good and great things in our daily lives, living with Jesus and like Jesus.

Once a man had a 'passcode' for his phone "pro nobis." His friend asked him, "what does it mean?" The man said, it was Latin and it meant "For Us." He choked up and became emotional, then went on saying, "After my parents divorce, I felt deep within me that God has given up on me; but finally I found hope through those two simple words - pro nobis (for us.) When he decided to believe in God's presence, God-was-with-him.

Brothers and sisters, never doubt Jesus' presence among-us, for-us, with-us. Always seeking the Lord Jesus, developing our friendship with Him, we learn how to listen to and know His Word, and to recognize Him in the members of your family; and in the poor of your own communities. "Us-with-God."

The angel told the shepherds, "Today born for you and for all people a Savior..." [Lk.2:9-10] They went to see him. That personal experience inspired them to glorify and praise God. (Lk. 2:20) When we see Jesus in others, beginning from our families, we see the truth that God is "pro nobis" (for us) in our family members.

Let us show our enthusiasm to everyone now and always that they will find the true and lasting joy.
