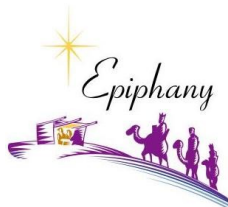

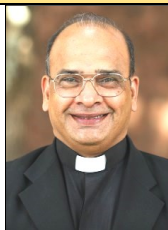

## Encountering Jesus



Dear brothers and sisters,

Wishing you and your family the special blessings of the Epiphany of our Lord. May Jesus, who revealed Himself to the wise men, guide you this year to be wise in following Him.

The Lord continues to reveal to the world through various ways from the beginning of creation, through the prophets and kings [Heb. 1:1-2]; through various events like revealing himself to the astrologists, who studied about the stars and apparently knew the prophecies very well; [Micah 5:2; Num.24:17] and believed in it. They were known as wise men - Melchior, Balthasar, and Gaspar, from three different nations (Babylonia, Persia, and India) They encountered a star of the King of Bethlehem at its rising. [Mt. 2:2] By their encounter, the wise men came to encounter the King of Jews and to worship Him.

After a simple information from the wise men, King Herod was troubled; then learned from the chief priests and scribes where the promised Christ was to be born. (Mt. 2:3-6) On learning that it was to be in Bethlehem, he told the astrologers to go there, look for the child, and report back to him – not to adore but to kill the boy, Jesus. The star led the wise men to Bethlehem. But for Herod, this encounter created a vengeful moment.

God encounters us to reveal His presence that we may search Him and find Him. Just like the wisemen, we need to believe in the prophecies in the Scripture and continue to seek Him. Herod sorted the Scriptures to find the birth place of King of the Jews; but didn't accept the Babe of Bethlehem as King, the truth from the Scriptures!

How is your experience or encounter of God in your life – do you reject it or question it, or accept it or believe it? May the Epiphany of Jesus bless your homes today and everyday of the New Year.

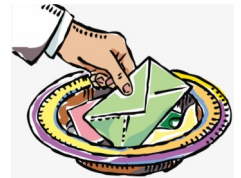

### Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton



**Feast Day: January 04**

**Birth:** August 28, 1774, New York City

**Death:** January 4, 1821

**Spouse:** William Magee Seton

**Patron of:** Catholic schools, widows, and seafarers

She faced many losses in her life. The deaths of many family members and the loss of financial security, strengthened her faith in God and her desire to do his will. She is an example to us when we are faced with difficult times and losses in our lives.

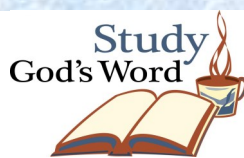
Elizabeth Ann Seton was kind, courteous, and patient. Daily, she sought to know and accept the will of God in her life. She died of tuberculosis in 1821

Education was very important to Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton. She started a Catholic school so that children could not only learn how to read and write but also learn about their Catholic faith.

Elizabeth Ann Seton was born in New York City. She was the daughter of a wealthy Protestant physician and was a part of the high society of New York. When Elizabeth was three years old, her mother died. Her early years were often lonely, and she spent much of her time reading. One of her favorite books to read was the Bible.

When Elizabeth was nineteen years old, she married William Magee Seton, a wealthy businessman.

Elizabeth Ann Seton was rejected by many of her Protestant family members and friends because of her Catholic faith. She started a Catholic school in Baltimore, Maryland.
