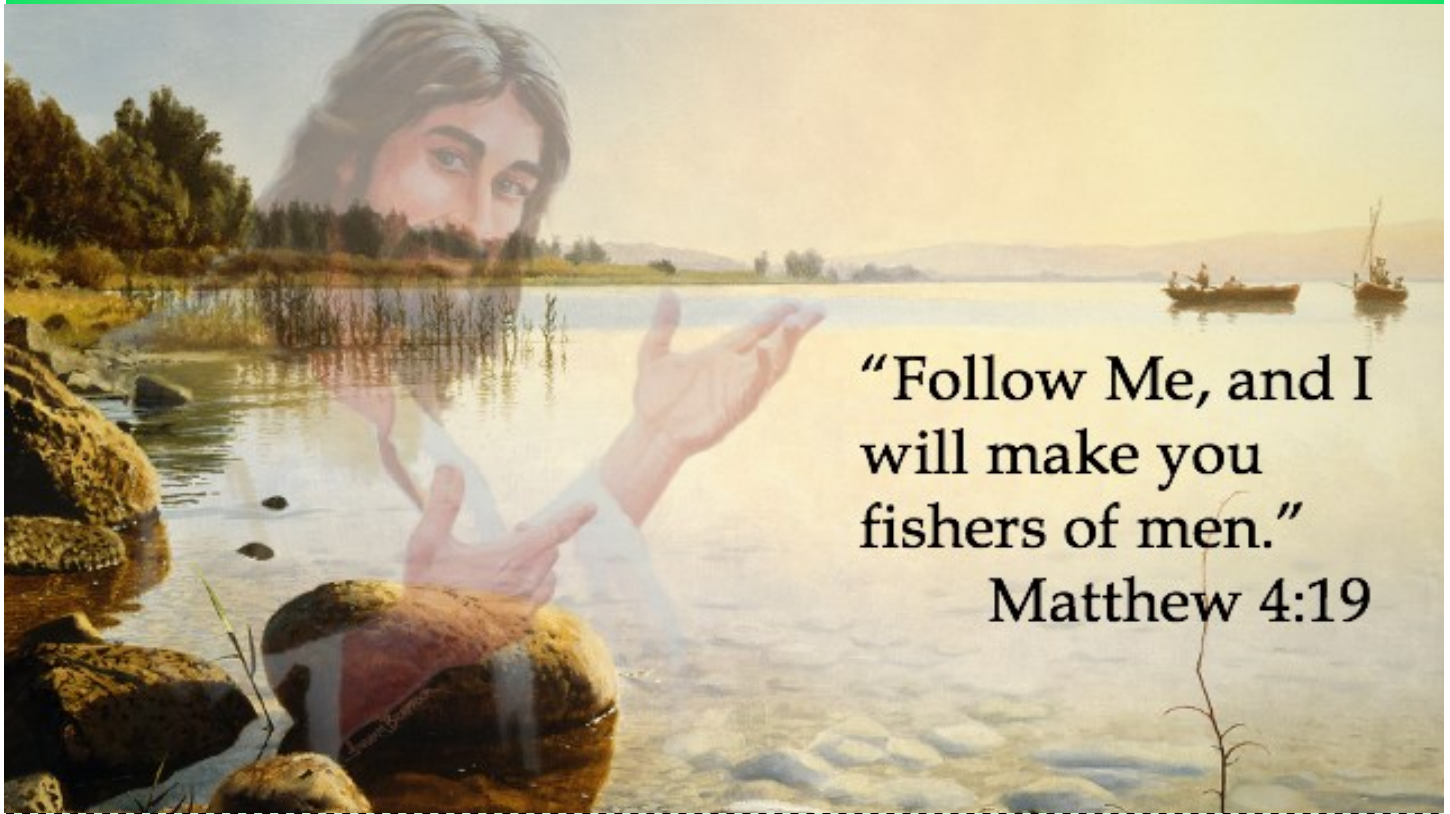

## God's Word: For Unity, not Uniformity

Dear brothers and sisters,  
 This week we celebrate "Word of God Sunday" and "Ecumenical Sunday." We pray for Christian unity, to be one in Christ.

Every denomination in the world learns and teaches the Word of God. Because, they all believe, "You can't do the will of God if you don't know the Word of God." St. Jerome said, "Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ!" St. Irenaeus says that the Word of God embraces the whole world, "its breadth and length, its height and depth, for through the Word of God all things are created, guided into order." God said, 'Let there be... they came to be.' [Genesis 1: 3-26] Therefore, God's words are creative, live and powerful. [Hebrews 4:12]

I heard a story about a priest who climbed up the church's steeple to be closer to God. He thought that by spending time up there, he would hear God's word more easily and then pass it on to his people. But the more time he spent up there, the further from God he felt. One day, in desperation he cried out, "God, speak to me! Where are you? Show yourself!" At that very moment the priest heard a voice coming from below, not from above, saying "My son, here I am! Down here on earth among my/your people!"

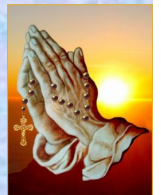
The Word of God well understood and religiously obeyed, like the Apostles, is the shortest route to spiritual perfection. And we must not select a few favorite passages to the exclusion of others. Nothing less than a whole Bible can make a whole Christian. After all, the Bible gives "Basic Instructions Before Leaving Earth."

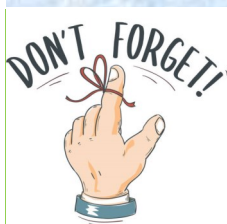

### **Saint Timothy Feast Day: January 26**

**Birth: AD 17 In Lystra Death: AD 97 in Ephesus**

**Patron of: Stomach and intestinal ailments**



Timothy was born in Lystra, a city in what is now the country of Turkey. His father was Greek, and his mother was Jewish.

It is believed that his grandmother was a Christian. When Paul came to Lystra as part of his first missionary trip to the

region, Timothy was around 20 years old.

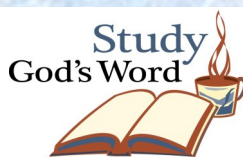
Timothy converted to Christianity and eventually joined Paul in his apostolic work. Over the years the two became good friends. Together they traveled through what is now Greece, Turkey and Israel to spread the Good News of Jesus Christ.

Timothy helped Paul in starting Christian communities in the ancient cities of Corinth, Thessalonica and Philippi. Paul had great respect for Timothy and thought of him as a son. In letters he wrote to Timothy, Paul indicates that his young friend was somewhat timid and was frequently ill. He encouraged Timothy to be strong and to take care of himself (1 Timothy 5:23.)

He also urged the communities to receive Timothy with warmth and hospitality. Timothy's kind and unselfish nature provided great comfort for Paul during difficult times.

Eventually Timothy went to Ephesus, where he was made bishop and lived for several years. When he tried to stop the worship of pagan idols, he was stoned to death by angry townspeople.

Timothy reminds us to be thankful for our true friends and strive to be a good and faithful friend to others.

Last week we looked at Matt. 16:13-19, where Jesus asks the Apostles who they said he was. We talked about how that is a very important question each of us must answer in our own lives.
