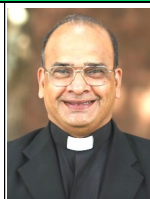

Barrier Breakers: God Vs Believer

Dear brothers and sisters,

We are gifted with faith. Our faith comes by hearing the word of God. God's word is "breathed out" into our hearts through the work of the Holy Spirit, causing faith to come alive. Does this faith give us an identity in our relationship with God and with one another? Does God recognize us by our faith?

A woman went to the bank to cash her check. When she approached the cashier, the cashier, citing the bank policy, asked for her identification. The woman gasped.... finally, she managed to say, "But Jonathan, I am your mother." For every transaction in our life, we need identification. How about with God!

Isaiah prophesized "Foreigners join themselves to the Lord, ministering to Him; loving the name of the Lord." I don't know what this Canaanite woman, a Gentile, an outsider, heard or how she heard it, but faith came alive in her heart; and her faith led her to Jesus. She called out in prayer publicly: "Lord, Son of David, have pity on me". Jesus tested her faith and made sure that she knew who He is, and who she is.

This event reveals to every believer, you and me, the assurance that Faith in God will work for any one, regardless of race, creed or color. Her faith broke the barriers and moved beyond limitations. Therefore, Jesus broke his barriers (only to lost sheep of Israel) and went beyond his limitations. When we set limitations in our faith, we offend God. The result of this is we feel offended by God.

Our faith must be fueled by desperate desire; be persistent at the moments of resistance, like the Canaanite woman whose faith made the Lord break Jesus' barriers. Our faith can break every barrier set by others; but if we set a barrier for ourselves, even God is not going to break it. Who can separate us from the love of Christ? [Read Rom. 8:35-39] Let us be 'the barrier breakers' by faith. Prayerful blessings! *Msgr. Xavier*

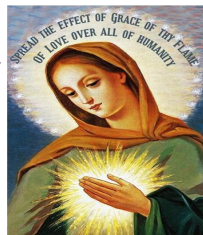

6. Utilize media to launch discussions about God and the Christian life.
7. Have a plan for family devotional and prayer times.
8. Have fun with your kids.
9. Get involved in ministry together as a family.
10. Disciple and equip your kids.

Show awareness of one's own gender and form appropriate relationships with people of other genders.

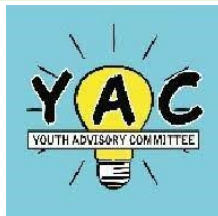
Guided Learning:

WHY YOUTH MINISTRY IS IMPORTANT?

The truth is that student ministry can be difficult. BUT it is important! Many times it's just easier to let teens do what they want at home or in the school or in the church. Three important things to know:

Youth ministry is discipleship, not just gathering a crowd. Our goal is to help teens follow Christ with all of their life. We are not just trying to reach teens, we are also trying to shape them to look more like Jesus. We see this happen by leading teens to engage in worship, study God's Word through relevant teaching, and process faith through small groups led by adult mentors. Our hope is to lead teens to be followers of Jesus with all their life.

The truth is that they are desperate for adults to actually show up and invest in their life on a consistent basis.

¿POR QUÉ ES IMPORTANTE LA MINISTERIO JUVENIL?

Church Personnel Certification VIRTUS Safe Environment

Before anyone begins work or volunteering in a ministry for the Church, they must have:

- ♦ A criminal background check (done at virtusonline.org).
- ♦ Commitment to the *Code of Conduct for Church Personnel*.
- ♦ Attendance at facilitated, in-person training session.

This process is an essential commitment of the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People* and our diocese. As before, the CPC must be renewed every three years in order to remain in compliance.

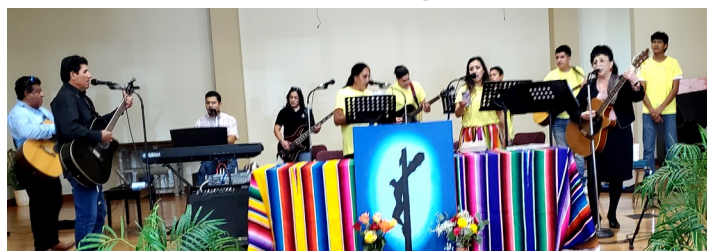
