Keys: Power Vs Authority

Dear brothers and sisters,

We are in the world of power strugglers or seekers. God shares His power and authority with us that we may serve and protect others as He does. Power is to protect from evil; and the authority is to serve everyone humbly and generously without seeking our name and fame.

God removed Shebna, who used his authority for his name and fame; and failed to serve his people from his office; and appointed Eliakim and gives him the authority and responsibility "put on his shoulders"- the key of the house of David - to "open . . . and shut." He could open the door, and no one could shut it. If he shut the door, no one could open it. This is extended as a Messianic prophesy [Is.9:6-7] to Jesus.

Jesus gives these "keys" of the kingdom to heaven, basing on the confession of Peter's Faith and says, "Whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven." Jesus changed the name of Simon to Peter, signifying that He assigns a new task to be a leader who governs His people by faith.

Faith, power, and authority are three necessary things for faithful Christians. Our faith in God gives power and authority to forgive sin, pronounce doctrinal judgments, take disciplinary action, to cast out unclean spirits and heal all manners of sickness and diseases.

A young man was apprenticed to a master artist who produced the most beautiful stained glass windows. The apprentice could not approach the master's genius, so he borrowed his master's tools, thinking that was the answer. After several weeks, the young man said to his teacher, 'I'm not doing any better with your tools than I did with mine.' The teacher replied, "So, it's not the tools of the master you need, but the spirit of the master."

The Holy Spirit is the "keys or power" who works constantly with our spirit to serve and protect our lives and others. Prayerful blessings!

10. Disciple and equip your kids.

- ♦ A criminal background check (done at virtusonline.org).
- ♦ Commitment to the *Code of Conduct for Church Personnel*.
- ♦ Attendance at facilitated, in-person training session.

This process is an essential commitment of the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People* and our diocese. As before, the CPC must be renewed every three years in order to remain in compliance.

WHY YOUTH MINISTRY IS IMPORTANT?

The truth is that student ministry can be difficult. BUT it is important! Many times it's just easier to let teens do what they want at home or in the school or in the church. Three important things to know:

Youth ministry is discipleship, not just gathering a crowd. Our goal is to help teens follow Christ with all of their life. We are not just trying to reach teens, we are also trying to shape them to look more like Jesus. We see this happen by leading teens to engage in worship, study God's Word through relevant teaching, and process faith through small groups led by adult mentors. Our hope is to lead teens to be followers of Jesus with all their life.

The truth is that they are desperate for adults to actually show up and invest in their life on a consistent basis.
