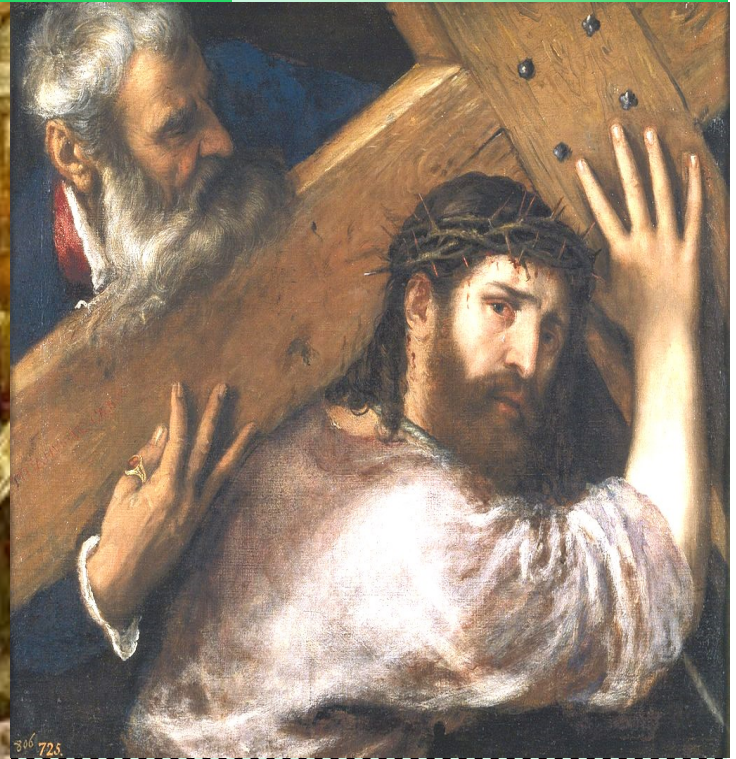

Appointed but Disappointed!

Dear brothers and sisters,

The young salesman was disappointed about losing a big sale, and as he talked with his sales manager he lamented, "I guess it just proves you can lead a horse to water but you can't make him drink." The manager replied, "Son, take my advice: your job is not to make him drink. Your job is to make him thirsty." So it is with evangelism; with our Christian faith. Our lives should be so filled with Christ that they create a thirst for God/Jesus.

All of us are chosen by God like the prophet Jeremiah, "I chose you before I formed you in the womb, I set you apart before you were born, to 'pluck up, pull down, destroy, overthrow, build, and plant.'" (Jer. 1:5) God promised to be with him every moment; but he felt duped and deceived by God when he faced rejection from people and felt deserted and disappointed. But his mission was to make people to thirst for God; and make them to accept him. Instead he sought acceptance by the people.

Jesus built His Church on Peter's Faith - humanly weak and divinely revealed - he gave the keys of the Kingdom with authority and responsibility. But... he disappointed Jesus by rebuking Him about His salvific plan - passion, death and resurrection. Jesus said, "You don't be an obstacle but be my follower - think with me and get behind me; Be ready to take up the cross and follow me. It was a disappointment for Peter, the keys of the Kingdom - power and authority - involves cross and death.

God is not out to get us or make us miserable or disappoint us; but has a plan for us to bless and prosper us. [Jer.29: 11] We need to seek first His will and not disappoint Him.

In life, you must make a decision saying, 'I am NOT going to disappoint God; I'm moving on with my life depending on His promises. Remember, If you do not "depend" on God, you will end up in the "deep end." You are chosen; appointed; anointed; authorized to glorify God. Prayerful blessings! Msgr. Xavier

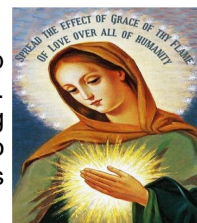

4. Look for natural opportunities to raise spiritual issues.
5. Take the posture of a 'fellow-learner' as opposed to that of a 'teacher and student.'
6. Utilize media to launch discussions about God and the Christian life.
7. Have a plan for family devotional and prayer times.
8. Have fun with your kids.
9. Get involved in ministry together as a family.
10. Disciple and equip your kids.

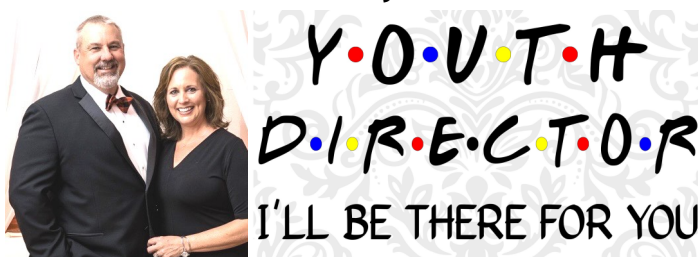

- ♦ Attendance at facilitated, in-person training session.

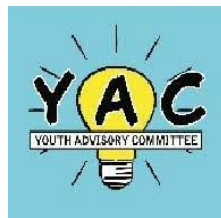
This process is an essential commitment of the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People* and our diocese. As before, the CPC must be renewed every three years in order to remain in compliance.

WHY YOUTH MINISTRY IS IMPORTANT?

The truth is that student ministry can be difficult. BUT it is important! Many times it's just easier to let teens do what they want at home or in the school or in the church. Three important things to know:

Youth ministry is discipleship, not just gathering a crowd. Our goal is to help teens follow Christ with all of their life. We are not just trying to reach teens, we are also trying to shape them to look more like Jesus. We see this happen by leading teens to engage in worship, study God's Word through relevant teaching, and process faith through small groups led by adult mentors. Our hope is to lead teens to be followers of Jesus with all their life.

The truth is that they are desperate for adults to actually show up and invest in their life on a consistent basis.
