God's Way Vs Our Ways

Dear brothers and sisters,

Isn't it funny how we meticulously plan our lives? We set goals, make to-do lists, and have five-year plans that look like roadmaps. And then, God seems to say, "Hold my divine intervention," and our plans go out the window.

Imagine if God's way had a GPS voice guiding us: "In 500 feet, turn left onto Patience Avenue. In 1 mile, merge onto Acceptance Lane." But, alas, we often stubbornly navigate life with our own internal GPS that says, "Make a U-turn, even if it's a dead end." (2 Sam. 22:31)

God's way often involves waiting. We wait for answers to prayers, for dreams to come true, and for change to happen. It's like being in a cosmic waiting room, and we're all just twiddling our spiritual thumbs. In this process of waiting, we learn to finally surrender to God's way, we realize that His plan has a lot more punchlines than our own. We find ourselves laughing at how stubbornly we clung to "my ways." (Jer. 10:23)

In the Gospel, the workers in the vineyard found the land owner is "not fair;" his thoughts and ways are not just in comparison with human thinking or standards. But God proves to be always just, fair, generous and keeps His word. The Prophet Isaiah experienced it. (Is. 55: 6-9)

It's okay to plan, dream, and desire, but we must also learn to laugh at life's twists and turns. Embracing God's way often means embracing the unexpected, and accepting that there are better ways to live.

So, let's not take ourselves too seriously. God's way is the scriptwriter. (Psalm 37:23-24) As we navigate the journey of life, let's remember to smile, laugh, and trust that even when our plans unravel, God's divine plan is always for our ultimate good. All we need to accept is: His ways are NOT our ways. Our past proves it!

Pro-Life: Month 6, Fetal Development

The baby sits erect now to accommodate the growing internal organs as they shift slightly into their proper places. Her oil and sweat glands are functioning; these help regulate body temperature. A white filmy layer covers the baby and protects her delicate skin from the surrounding amniotic fluid and from scratches as she twists and turns. This waxy substance will be quickly absorbed into her skin soon after she is born. She can now respond to sound. Her lungs are fairly well developed and she would stand a good chance of survival if born at this time.

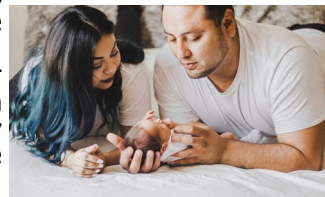

INTENTIONAL PARENTING

If you are blessed with the gift of children, God has given you the most incredible opportunity and responsibility to help your child know, love and follow Jesus.

Every believing parent hopes their child will embrace the faith and grow deep spiritual roots. Studies tell us that over half of those growing up in Christian homes will walk away from Christianity by the time they leave the teen years.



One reason is that parents often "outsource" the spiritual formation of their children to the church.

While a good church is very important, God designed the family to be the primary place where faith is nurtured. The scriptures tell us that what we do today directly influences the multi-generational cycle of family traits, beliefs and actions – for good or bad. (Exodus 20:5-6, Psalm 78:5-8).

Passing a strong faith to our children begins by having a strong faith ourselves, modeling the gospel in our marriages and in how we relate to those closest to us.



10 tips

you can use as you engage your children on a daily basis to share your faith.

1. Tell Your Story:

Take a moment to think about your own story. How did God use the circumstances in your life to bring you to Himself? When did you realize that there was more to life? How did that affect your decisions? Share your mistakes, challenges and victories to lead your child to Christ.

2. Institute Family Prayer

In a world that is growing busier and busier every day, it can be difficult to find time to raise kids who know God. However, by instituting family prayer, you can help your kids spend more time with Him. Spend time in the morning before they go to school or before they go to bed to talk about their day and to ask them if they want prayer in a specific area. This can serve as meaningful family time as well as a model for your children to learn about prayer. [TO BE CONTINUED]

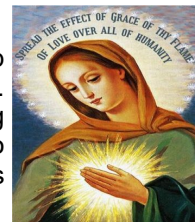

Before anyone begins work or volunteering in a ministry for the Church, they must have:

- ♦ A criminal background check (done at virtusonline.org).
- ♦ Commitment to the *Code of Conduct for Church Personnel*.
- ♦ Attendance at facilitated, in-person training session.

This process is an essential commitment of the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People* and our diocese. As before, the CPC must be renewed every three years in order to remain in compliance.
