World's peace Vs God's Peace Dear brothers and sisters,

I wish you and your near and dear ones a Joy-filled Christmas. May it not be one of the events of our life, but BE THE event that fills you with joy and peace.

Today it is rare to find people who are truly at peace. Most people are busy... stressed.... tired... and burdened. But rarely do we run into people who are living in peace. Peace is a rare quality but it's the reason Jesus came. God sent Jesus at Christmas to bring us peace. 700 years before Jesus, Isaiah predicted that the Savior of the world would come and he would be called the Prince of Peace. Then at Jesus' birth, the Angels sang, "... peace on earth to those with whom God is pleased." Luke 2:14. Jesus said that He came to give 'peace' that none – relationship, bottles, fun activities, etc., can give. Jesus offers at His birth three kinds of peace: Spiritual Peace, Emotional Peace and Relational Peace; or Eternal Peace, Internal Peace, External Peace

Jesus brings Peace with God: spiritual or eternal. This is the most important because it affects everything else. You begin with peace with God. Jesus came to make peace between God and us. Jesus is "Emmanuel – Godwith-us." He is our peace.

Jesus brings Peace within me. Internal / emotional. This is the Peace OF God. This is internal peace... it is your emotional peace. It's the one that feels good. This peace also brings comfort to you when you are hurting. When you feel ashamed, he gives forgiving peace.

Jesus brings Peace with others. Relational / external. The absence of peace in our life messes up our relationships with other people... the more conflict you will have with others. The world is not becoming more peaceful, but more fractured and dysfunctional. Jesus brings us together and when we have peace with him, we can have peace with each other.


There is a particular focus on the Our Father, and this presents us with a great opportunity to go back to the basics of prayer.
