I am sure you had a great celebration of Christmas with your family and friends. Let us thank God for everything - pleasant and unpleasant events in the year 2023. Every thing made us to grow and glorify God. I

wish you and your family a blessed and prosperous New Year 2024!

In preparation for the Jubilee year 2025, 'Pilgrims of Hope', 2024 has been designated a Year of Prayer by Pope Francis. It started this Advent, on December 3rd. with focus on the Our Father; and this presents us with a great opportunity to go back to the basics of prayer.

Someone said, "The great tragedy of life is not unanswered prayers, but un-offered prayers." Instead of prayer being something we do every day, like breathing, eating, walking and talking, it seems to have become like "break in case of emergency."

I heard a story the other day of a man who encountered a bit of trouble while flying his little airplane. He called the control tower and said, "Pilot to tower, I'm 300 miles from the airport, six hundred feet above the ground, and I'm out of fuel. I am descending rapidly. Please advise. Over." "Tower to pilot," the dispatcher began, "Repeat after me: "Our Father Who art in heaven..."

It is true that so very often we associate prayer with crises in our life. It is better to pray before to prevent problems than pray during problems. Prayer is talking to and consulting God about anything and everything. It is practiced less than anything else.

May we during the "Year of Prayer" practice our personal prayer at all times; and pray together in/with our families a minimum of 15 minutes everyday. without prayer is a day without blessing, and a life without prayer is a life without power." Have a Blessed New

There is a particular focus on the Our Father, and this presents us with a great opportunity to go back to the basics of praver.



Our Father, Who art in Heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen. Let us pray this prayer everyday with our children; and teach this prayer. Also pray: "Hail **Mary**" everyday and pray with the church for us and for everyone.

Due to War between Israel & Hamas **Christmas Celebration is Cancelled** in Bethlehem (Jesus' birth place.)

In Bangladesh: Dec. 25 is public holiday even though only 0.03% of the population are Christians. [85% of people are Muslims.] Christmas celebrated in towns, cities, shops and



hotels western style. They exchange gifts even with Muslim friends as well. There is midnight service in the churches. Traditionally, men and women sit on either side during the Mass. Christmas dinner is called, 'Prem-bhoj', 'Love-feast".

In India: Christians (about 2.3%) compared to people who belong to other religions. The population of India is over 1 Billion, so there are over 25 million Christians in India! Midnight Mass is a very important service in India. The whole family will celebrate the Mass, wearing new dress, and exchange gifts after the Mass. In Southern India, Christians decorate their homes with Christmas lights, share gifts & food with their neighbors of all religions. The tribal Christians of the Bhil folk, go out night after night for a week at Christmas to sing their own carols the whole night through. They go to surrounding villages singing to people and telling the Christmas story. [source: whychristmas.com]



- ♦ A criminal background check (done at virtusonline.org).
- ♦ Commitment to the *Code of Conduct for Church Personnel*.
- ♦ Attendance at facilitated, in-person training session.

This process is an essential commitment of the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People* and our diocese. As before, the CPC must be <u>renewed every three years</u> in order to remain in compliance.

How does the world Celebrate New Year?

May 2024, a Year of Prayer, be a year of good fortune with a generous dose of sanity. And don't forget to make those New Year's resolutions. We need all the good luck we can get!

United States: Watching the ball drop: Millions of Americans gather around their television sets (or on the streets of Times Square, despite freezing temps) to watch the ball drop at the stroke of midnight each year.



Brazil: Heading to the beach: "In Brazil, people usually go to the beach since it's the summer there," says Hudson Bohr, a Brazilian photographer based in NYC. "Immediately after midnight, you're supposed to jump seven waves while making seven wishes."

Spain: The Spanish start off their new year by eating 12 grapes, which symbolize each strike of the clock; and eat all of the grapes in a matter of seconds since they need to be gone by the time the clock finishes striking midnight.

India: People make an effigy of an 'old man' that symbolized the old year and burn it at midnight. The old is gone; and new is born. All Christians have a midnight service in the church as to begin the New Year with the blessings of God.

Denmark: New Year's Eve traditions like this bring your loved ones the best luck. Tradition has it that the more broken kitchenware you accumulate on your door step, the better off you'll be.




