Listening to God & Godly mentors

Dear brothers and sisters,

During this "Year of Prayer" we reflect on God's Calling: The calling of Samuel and Andrew and his companion.

Samuel's experience illustrates how God calls individuals to serve Him. It emphasizes

the importance of being attentive and receptive to God's voice in our lives. Samuel listened to God. It highlights the need for us to actively listen to God through prayer, meditation, and a willingness to submit to His will.

When the call was not clearly understood, Eli, the priest, helped Samuel to discern God's voice. In the same scenario we read that John the Baptist pointed out Jesus to his disciples — Andrew and his companion. It underscores the significance of wise and experienced mentors in our spiritual journey who can guide and direct us. Andrew, having encountered Jesus, brings his brother to share his experience of God.

President Franklin D. Roosevelt got tired of smiling and saying the usual things at all those White House receptions. So, one evening he decided to find out whether anybody was paying attention to what he was saying. As each person came up to him with an extended hand, he flashed that big smile and said, "I murdered my grandmother this morning." People would automatically respond with comments such as "How lovely!" Nobody listened to what he was saying, except one foreign diplomat. When the president said, "I murdered my grandmother this morning," the diplomat responded softly." I'm sure she had it coming to her."

Listening becomes one of the most important virtues in our daily living and in our prayer life - being open to God's calling, seeking guidance from godly mentors to live and demonstrate obedience in our walk with God. Listening is the beginning of relationship with God and with others.

Let us develop a listening heart.



St. Joseph Vaz Feast day: January 16



St. Joseph Vaz was a missionary in Sri Lanka in the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries. He was born in India in 1651, ordained a priest in 1676, and left for missionary work in Canara, India in 1681. After three years there, he returned to his hometown.

joined the Congregation of the Oratory of St. Philip Neri, and in 1687 left for missionary work in Sri Lanka.

He spent the last twenty-four years of his life working throughout Sri Lanka in secret for part of that time because Catholicism was outlawed in the country. His priority in Sri Lanka was not only missionary work but also caring for the temporal needs of those he encountered throughout his missions in the country.

Joseph Vaz was canonized by Pope Francis on January 14, 2015 in Colombo at Galleface, Sri Lanka. Joseph Vaz is the first saint to have been canonised in Sri Lanka, the first saint of Sri Lanka (having died there) and first originally from the area of Goa, India




