



#### Prayer: To Discern and to Decide

Dear brothers and sisters,

When God calls us to serve, our initial reaction is resistance and an attempt to flee. God calls us not only once but several times, as he called Jonah. Once God has cast His eve on us, we are in His circle and in His

mind for something! This reveals God's persistence in reaching out to us, even when we may initially resist His calling. After hearing God's call for the second or third time, Jonah responds by rising and going to Nineveh. In prayer he discerned that led him to accept God's calling.

Jonah's message invited the Ninevites to make a prayerful decision to repent; and the people, with a deep sense of prayer, responded with fasting and repentance. Our prayer, too, should align with God's will and prompt a response within us. Thus, prayer is not just about making requests but also about accepting God's plan and surrendering to His will. Our prayer turns out to be not only personal, but also a communal one, and it brings a community, a nation to conversion.

A young Christian went to an older believer to ask for prayer. "Will you please pray that I may be more patient?" he asked. The aged believer agreed. They knelt together and the man began to pray, "Lord, send this young man tribulation in the morning; tribulation in the afternoon; and ....." At that point, the young Christian blurted out, "No, no, I didn't ask you to pray for tribulation. I wanted you to pray for patience." "Ah," responded the aged Christian, "it's through tribulation that you learn patience."

Our prayer is a vehicle for accepting and aligning with God's purpose in our lives and leading to a new way of life - "fishermen become fishers of men." The encounter - or prayer experience - helped them to discern and leave behind their comfort zones and decide to embrace the unknown in response to God's calling.

Let everything you decide be discerned in prayer!

## Evangelize, Catechize and Form Disciples

Saint Timothy Feast Day: January 26 Birth: AD 17 In Lystra Death: AD 97 in Ephesus Patron of: Stomach and intestinal ailments



Timothy was born in Lystra, a city in what is now the country of Turkey. His father was Greek, and his mother was Jewish. It is believed that his grandmother was a Christian. When Paul came to Lystra as

part of his first missionary trip to the

region, Timothy was around 20 years old.

Timothy converted to Christianity and eventually joined Paul in his apostolic work. Over the years the two became good friends. Together they traveled through what is now Greece, Turkey and Israel to spread the Good News of Jesus Christ.

Timothy helped Paul in starting Christian communities in the ancient cities of Corinth, Thessalonica and Philippi. Paul had great respect for Timothy and thought of him as a son. In letters he wrote to Timothy, Paul indicates that his young friend was somewhat timid and was frequently ill. He encouraged Timothy to be strong and to take care of himself (1 Timothy 5:23.)

He also urged the communities to receive Timothy with warmth and hospitality. Timothy's kind and unselfish nature provided great comfort for Paul during difficult times.

Eventually Timothy went to Ephesus, where he was made bishop and lived for several years. When he tried to stop the worship of pagan idols, he was stoned to death by angry townspeople.

Timothy reminds us to be thankful for our true friends and strive to be a good and faithful friend to others.


