

#### 8. Hope: An Active Trust in God

Dear brothers and sisters,

True hope is rooted in trusting God extending love to others, and responding to challenges with the grace of God gracefully!
Once a dad was climbing some cliffs with his 5 year old son; he heard a voice from above yelling, "Hey Dad, Catch me!" The

Dad turned around to see his son joyfully jumping off a rock straight at him. He jumped and yelled "Hey Dad." The dad became an instant circus actor, catching him,

both fell on the ground. The dad asked his son, "Can you give one good reason why you did that?" He replied, "Sure.. Because you're my dad."

Biblical hope is not passive optimism but active trust in God's promises. David's trusted in God's plan, (1 Sam. 26) refused to take revenge on Saul



and let God's action to deliver justice on "the Lord's anointed" and said, "God will deal with Saul in His timing" and showed him forgiveness and compassion.

Jesus' radical call to love and forgiveness (Luke 6) as expressions of hope in action - "Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful;" "Give, and it will be given to you." It's not material giving but offering hope, grace, mercy, love, etc. Our hope in God would help us even when it is difficult to give these. "Do not take revenge, but leave room for God to act." (Rom. 12:19) Duties are ours, events are God's; our faith is not to meddle with events!

What oxygen is for the lungs, such is hope for the meaning of human/Christian life. Take oxygen away and death occurs through suffocation, take hope away and humanity is constricted through lack of breath; despair and hopelessness set in.

May we place our trust in God when facing opposition in life, leaving justice in God's hands! *Msgr. Xavier*

#### **40 CANS FOR LENT**



#### **Fasting & Abstinence**

**Fasting** is defined as having one full meal a day, and is required only on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. This requirement is for ages 18 to 59, but younger and older may participate.

**During Lent** abstinence from meat on Friday's is obligatory in the United States, as elsewhere, for all Catholics age 14 until death.

Getting caught up in the rubrical requirements, however, misses the point. Fasting is meaningless unless our hearts fast from obstacles blocking our way to true discipleship.

# Discipline as a Faith Expectation Catholic schools promote selfdiscipline through clarity of moral vision that is based on the Gospel. Students are challenged to be



Christ-like in word and action. They are asked to examine their choices and action in light of the Ten Commandments and the Gospel law of love. They are given a theological foundation for ethical behavior. Students are not good because they act in accord with rules and expectations. Through Catholic education, students are exposed to the richness of the religious tradition. Music, Art, Literature, Drama and Ritual are rooted in the rich history of the Church, and find their truest glory as an expression of divine praise.

## The Fullness of the Catholic Identity at the Heart of the Church

Catholic education has always been at the heart of the Catholic mission. Catholic education, and the students who are the product of it, have been called the "greatest work of the Church." They have been entrusted with the fullness of faith and have been charged with the mission of evangelization. They are to go out into the world and share the gifts they have received, as doctors, lawyers, policemen, firemen, businessmen and women, teachers, priests and religious, all as Catholic school graduates. Catholic school graduates are a leaven in society, helping the broader community to be the best that it can be.

#### Personal Excellence as a Spiritual Goal

Catholic school students learn that excellence is a response to God's blessings. Academic excellence is not a gospel value in and of itself. The Sermon on the Mount doesn't say "Blessed are you who get all A's." Education must have an altruistic orientation. Students learn so as to help others, and make a difference in the world around them.


