

10. Lenten Journey of Hope



Dear brothers and sisters,

Lent is a sacred journey, a pilgrimage that leads us from the wilderness / desert of

our struggles to the promise of new life. This year, as pilgrims of hope, we are invited to walk with Jesus, facing trials and temptations, yet trusting in His grace.

Jesus enters the wilderness led by the Spirit. His fasting and prayer prepare Him for the trials ahead. He faces three temptations from the devil:

Physical Need (Turning Stones to Bread): The devil

tempts Jesus to satisfy His hunger by relying on His power rather than on God's providence.

<u>Seeking Power</u> (Worshiping the Devil): Jesus is offered dominion over the world in exchange for worshiping Satan, but He remains faithful to the one true God.



<u>Testing God</u> (Jumping from Temple): The devil twists Scripture to challenge Jesus to prove God's protection, but Jesus refuses to put God to the test.

A blacksmith heats iron in a blazing furnace before hammering it into shape. Without the fire, the metal remains rigid and unusable. The intense heat refines and strengthens it. God allows trials to refine us. (1 Peter 1:6-7) His grace is the fire that purifies us, making us stronger in faith and character.

Daily we face our own desert experiences - moments of doubt, hardship, and temptation. Jesus shows us that victory comes not through human strength but through reliance on God's Word to resist the false promises of the world. We are nourished by Christ's body and blood, the Eucharist. If possible, participate in a daily Mass and receive the Eucharist; and pray every day: "Be with me, Lord, when I am in trouble."

Fasting & Abstinence

Fasting is defined as having one full meal a day, and is required only on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. This requirement is for ages 18 to 59, but younger and older may participate.

During Lent abstinence from meat on Friday's is obligatory in the United States, as elsewhere, for all Catholics age 14 until death.

Getting caught up in the rubrical requirements, however, misses the point. Fasting is meaningless unless our hearts fast from obstacles blocking our way to true discipleship.



If we don't teach our children to FOLLOW GOD'S WAYS the world will teach them NOT TO. Let us be responsible teachers in leading their way.


What can I do ... as a youth ... for Lent?

- 1. Think about what you usually spend your money on. Do you buy too many clothes? Spend too much on dinner out? Pick one type of expenditure that you'll "fast" from during Lent, and then give the money you would usually spend to a local charity.
- 2. Take something on 40 days of letter writing, 40 days of reading Bible, 40 acts of kindness, 40 phone calls to the important people or friends in your life to encourage them.
- 3. When you first sit down in front of your computer, or at the very end of your day, try a 10-minute guided prayer based on the spiritual exercises of St. Ignatius or any other saint.
- 4. Go to (or watch) a weekday Mass one day during the week. Daily Masses are often more intimate and shorter than Sunday Mass. Come up with something that reminds you that "God is for you".
- 5. If you don't have a crucifix in your room or house, get one and pray in front of it before you go to bed; and after you rise in the morning.


