17. Divine Mercy is Our Hope

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

I hope and pray that you and your family celebrated the Easter filled with Joy and Peace. Our next step is to share this joy and peace with others with mercy, as Jesus did to His disciples and friends.

On this Divine Mercy Sunday, the Church invites us to gaze upon the heart of Jesus - pierced for love of us - and rediscover the hope that comes from His boundless mercy. No matter how broken, lost, or weary we may feel, His mercy reaches deeper still. This is the day when heaven declares: *"There is no sin too great for My mercy. Come back to Me."*

A priest in California was called late one Sunday night to administer the last rites to a dying Catholic man. When he arrived, the man angrily rejected him multiple times. After patiently waiting and returning a third time, the man finally opened up, confessing a tragic accident from forty years ago. While working at a railway, he had caused a fatal crash due to drunken negligence, killing a woman and two children. Haunted by guilt, he had lived a life of isolation and despair. Listening carefully, the priest asked a few details about the accident. Then, to the man's astonishment, the priest revealed that he had survived that very crash as a boy and had grown up to become a priest. With deep compassion, he said to the dying man, "I forgive you." Mercy is to share!

Divine Mercy isn't just a devotion - it's a lifeline. It is God leaning down to us in our lowest moments and lifting us up with love. Whether we are like Thomas, doubting, or like the disciples, hiding in fear, Jesus comes through locked doors and says, *"Peace be with you."* (John 20:19)

Let our families become THE place of Divine mercy. Prayers and blessings! - Msgr. Xavier

A **pastoral pope** who prioritizes **people over protocols**, often emphasizing accompaniment and mercy over judgment.

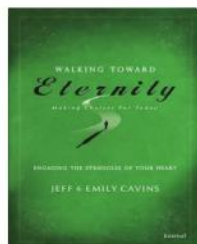

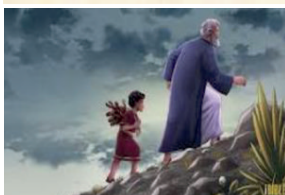

Dress Code: First Holy Communion & Confirmation

Girls: Dresses are NOT to be shorter than the knee or longer than the ankle. NO FORMALS. For those receiving First Holy Communion, the dress code is white; for the Confirmands, any color is permitted. Dress shoes or dress sandals (no tennis shoes). No dresses with spaghetti straps or without sleeves will be permitted. Without proper dress you may not be permitted to participate in the sacraments.

Boys: 1st Holy Communion: Dress shirt must be white, long or short sleeve. Dress pants may be white, navy blue or black. Ties - white, navy blue or black;

Boys: Confirmation: Dress shirt of any solid color. Dark dress pants - navy blue or black; (no tennis shoes); Suit coats or jackets are optional (not a requirement).



A Test of Faith

Time passed, and Isaac grew up to be a kind and helpful young boy. He loved his parents very much, and they loved him more than anything in the world. But one day, something unexpected happened that would change their lives forever.

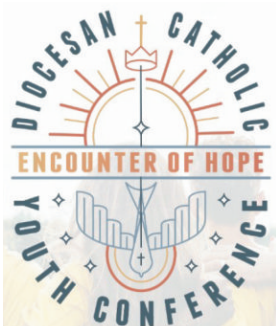

17. La Divina Misericordia es Nuestra Esperanza

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Espero para que ustedes y sus familias hayan celebrado la Pascua llenos de alegría y paz. Nuestro siguiente paso es compartir esta alegría y paz con los demás con misericordia, como Jesús lo hizo con sus discípulos y amigos.

En este Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, la Iglesia nos invita a contemplar el corazón de Jesús. No importa cuán destrozados, perdidos o cansados nos sintamos, su misericordia llega aún más profundo. Este es el día en que el cielo declara: «No hay pecado demasiado grande para mi misericordia. Regresen a mí».

Un domingo por la noche, un sacerdote en California fue llamado para administrar la extremaunción a un católico moribundo. Al llegar, el hombre lo rechazó con enojo varias veces. Tras esperar pacientemente y regresar por tercera vez, el hombre finalmente se sinceró y confesó un trágico accidente ocurrido hacía cuarenta años: mientras trabajaba en el ferrocarril, había provocado un accidente fatal por negligencia ebria, en el que murieron una mujer y dos niños. Atormentado por la culpa, había vivido una vida de aislamiento y desesperación. Escuchándolo atentamente, el sacerdote le preguntó algunos detalles del accidente. Entonces, para asombro del hombre, el sacerdote reveló que había sobrevivido a ese mismo accidente siendo niño y que se había convertido en sacerdote. Con profunda compasión, le dijo al moribundo: «Te perdono». **¡La misericordia es para compartir!**

La Divina Misericordia no es solo una devoción, es un salvavidas. Es Dios inclinándose hacia nosotros en nuestros momentos más difíciles y levantándonos con amor. Ya sea que seamos como Tomás, dudando, o como los discípulos, escondidos por el miedo, Jesús entra por las puertas cerradas y dice: «La paz sea con ustedes» (Juan 20:19).

Que nuestras familias se conviertan en EL lugar de la Divina Misericordia. ¡Oraciones y bendiciones!
