18. A Tribute to Pope Francis: His Message of Hope

Dear brothers and sisters,
 We are sad about Pope Francis' passing. As we reflect on Pope Francis' legacy and leadership, we are challenged to be signs of hope in our families, our communities, and our world.

His message of hope is not abstract or reserved for the few - it is living, breathing, and deeply rooted in the reality of everyday life. He calls on us to look beyond ourselves and to seek the face of Christ in the poor, the migrant, the marginalized, and even in those with whom we disagree.

His hope is not passive; it is active. It compels us to build bridges, not walls. To forgive, not condemn. To care for creation, not exploit it. It is a hope that uplifts, that moves the heart to action, and that renews the spirit.

He spoke often of "joyful hope," a phrase that encapsulates the heart of his papacy. It is the kind of hope that sings in the silence of suffering, that waits patiently in the face of adversity, and that persists even when the world offers little reason to go on. In a world tired of cynicism, Pope Francis dared us to believe again - in goodness, in one another, and in the transforming power of God's mercy.

Perhaps his most powerful contribution is the reminder that hope is not naive. It is a choice. A discipline. A virtue. And in making that choice daily, we align ourselves with the Gospel message that no darkness is so great that it can overcome the light.

To us who walk with courage, love boldly, and believe that, through faith and unity, a better world is not only possible but promised. "Do not let yourselves be robbed of hope."

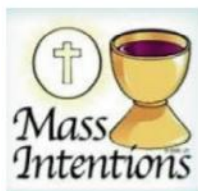

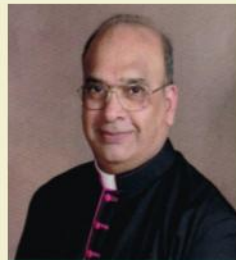

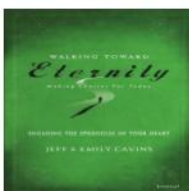

Dress Code: First Holy Communion & Confirmation

Girls: Dresses are NOT to be shorter than the knee or longer than the ankle. NO FORMALS. For those receiving First Holy Communion, the dress code is white; for the Confirmands, any color is permitted. Dress shoes or dress sandals (no tennis shoes). No dresses with spaghetti straps or without sleeves will be permitted. Without proper dress you may not be permitted to participate in the sacraments.

Boys: 1st Holy Communion: Dress shirt must be white, long or short sleeve. Dress pants may be white, navy blue or black. Ties - white, navy blue or black;

Boys: Confirmation: Dress shirt of any solid color. Dark dress pants - navy blue or black; (no tennis shoes); Suit coats or jackets are optional (not a requirement).



A Test of Faith

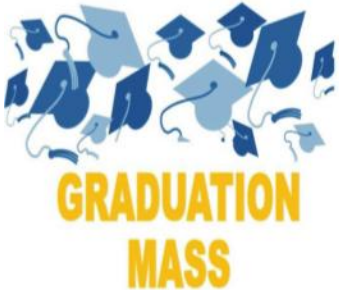

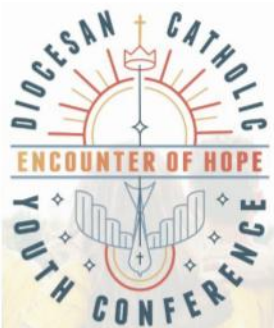

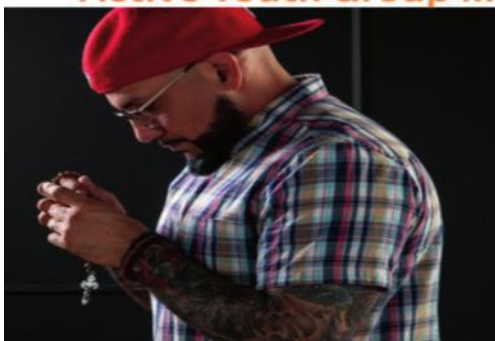

18. Un homenaje al Papa Francisco: Su mensaje de esperanza

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

Nos entristece el fallecimiento del Papa Francisco. Al reflexionar sobre su legado y liderazgo, nos vemos interpelados a ser signos de esperanza en nuestras familias, comunidades y el mundo.

Su mensaje de esperanza no es abstracto ni reservado para unos pocos - es vivo, palpitante y profundamente arraigado en la realidad de la vida cotidiana. Nos llama a mirar más allá de nosotros mismos y a buscar el rostro de Cristo en los pobres, los migrantes, los marginados e incluso en aquellos con quienes no estamos de acuerdo. Su esperanza no es pasiva; es activa. Nos impulsa a construir puentes, no muros. A perdonar, no a condenar. A cuidar la creación, no a explotarla. Es una esperanza que eleva, que mueve el corazón a la acción y que renueva el espíritu.

Habló a menudo de la «gozosa esperanza», una frase que resume la esencia de su papado. Es la clase de esperanza que canta en el silencio del sufrimiento, que espera pacientemente ante la adversidad y que persiste incluso cuando el mundo ofrece pocas razones para seguir adelante. En un mundo cansado del cinismo, el Papa Francisco nos retó a creer de nuevo: en la bondad, en los demás y en el poder transformador de la misericordia de Dios.

Quizás su contribución más poderosa sea recordarnos que la esperanza no es ingenua. Es una elección. Una disciplina. Una virtud. Y al tomar esa decisión a diario, nos alineamos con el mensaje del Evangelio de que ninguna oscuridad es tan grande que pueda vencer la luz.

A nosotros que caminamos con valentía y creer que, mediante la fe y la unidad, un mundo mejor no solo es posible, sino prometido. «No se dejen robar la esperanza».

Niñas: Los vestidos NO deben ser más cortos que la rodilla ni más largos que el tobillo. SIN FORMALES. Para aquellos que reciben la Primera Comunión, el código de vestimenta es blanco; para los Confirmandos, se permite cualquier color. Zapatos de vestir o sandalias de vestir (no tenis). No se permitirán vestidos con tirantes finos o sin mangas. Sin la vestimenta adecuada, es posible que no se le permita participar en los sacramentos.

Niños - Primera Comunión: La camisa de vestir debe ser blanca, manga larga o corta. Los pantalones de vestir pueden ser blancos, azul marino o negros. 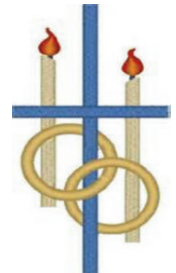
