20. Hope in Home, is Heaven

Dear brothers and sisters,

A little girl was once overheard praying, "God, I heard you're making everything new. Can you start with my family?" It's a childlike request, but a deeply human one. Christian hope is not wishful thinking - it is rooted in the promise that God is making all things new. Not just in heaven, but starting here and now. Our family is God's construction zone, starting with us.

To accomplish this, "it is necessary to undergo many hardships to enter the Kingdom of God." We can't take away every hardship. But we can encourage, strengthen and build up hope to keep going. Each of us is under construction with a blue print of hope that God has for us. He prepares each of us for that new home.

The guideline is: "Love one another as Jesus has loved you." This is the kind of love we learn, practice and live within our family relationships. Only by welcoming, sacrificing, forgiving, never giving up on each other, and cultivating good qualities can a home become a sanctuary, a place where individuals feel safe, loved, and supported. I refer to this as, "Hope lived at home makes our home a heaven on earth." Christian hope will keep the heart both from aching and breaking, from fainting and sinking; because, hope is a beam of God.

John, the disciple whom Jesus loved, sees "the new heaven and new earth." We are loved by Jesus. Our love in our home is not passive, but active and as such helps us to experience heaven on earth. The love that we have for each other plants seeds of hope and grows to be Christ himself. God has not finished his work yet. He is at work in each of us - making our home a heaven daily.

Prayer Blankets

How?: Just call or email the church office or Msgr. Xavier with a brief description of the person who needs our prayers.

Why?: We do this because all of us have a responsibility to pray for our parish family members; and not all of us will be able to visit the sick brothers or sisters personally.

Where?: After all the weekend Masses, you may get the blanket from Msgr. Xavier and send it to the person for whom we prayed.

You may also bring your own small blanket to be prayed over by our parish community.

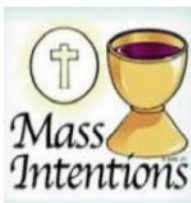

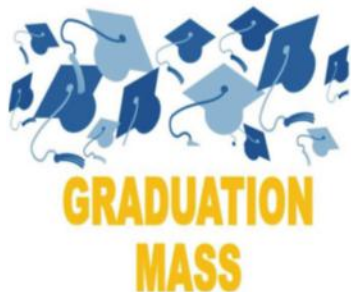

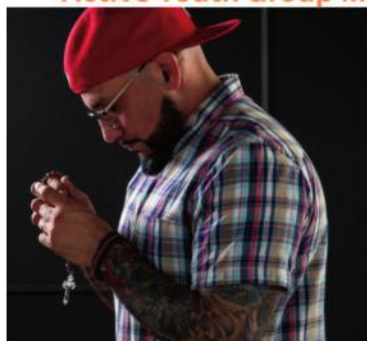

20. La Esperanza Hace de un Hogar un Cielo

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

Una vez se escuchó a una niña orar: «Dios, escúchame que estás renovando todo. ¿Puedes empezar con mi familia?». Es una petición infantil, pero profundamente humana. La esperanza cristiana no es una ilusión; se basa en la promesa de que Dios está renovando todas las cosas. No solo en el cielo, sino comenzando aquí y ahora. Nuestra familia es la zona de construcción de Dios, comenzando por nosotros.

Para lograrlo, «es necesario pasar por muchas dificultades para entrar en el Reino de Dios». No podemos eliminar todas las dificultades. Pero podemos animar, fortalecer y alimentar la esperanza para seguir adelante. Cada uno de nosotros está en construcción con un plan de esperanza que Dios tiene para nosotros. Él nos prepara para ese nuevo hogar.

La guía es: «Ámense los unos a los otros como Jesús los ha amado». Este es el tipo de amor que aprendemos, practicamos y vivimos en nuestras relaciones familiares: acogiendo, sacrificando, perdonando; nunca nos abandonamos; cultivamos las buenas cualidades; así, un hogar puede convertirse en un santuario, un lugar donde las personas se sienten seguras, amadas y apoyadas. A esto le llamo: «La esperanza vivida en casa hace de nuestro hogar un paraíso terrenal». La esperanza cristiana protegerá el corazón del dolor y la ruptura, del desmayo y el hundimiento; porque la esperanza es un rayo de Dios.

Juan, el discípulo a quien Jesús amaba, ve "el cielo nuevo y la tierra nueva". Jesús nos ama. Nuestro amor en el hogar no es pasivo, sino activo, lo que nos ayuda a experimentar el cielo en la tierra. El amor que nos tenemos los unos a los otros siembra semillas de esperanza y crece hasta convertirse en Cristo mismo. Dios aún no ha terminado su obra. Él está obrando en cada uno de nosotros, haciendo de nuestro hogar un paraíso cada día.
