21. Jesus' Prayer of Hope

Dear brothers and sisters,

Jesus prays - not only for His disciples but for *all* of us who will believe through their word. He prays with hope, with love, and with longing. His deepest desire? "That they may all be one." A prayer for unity, not just superficial peace, but true life rooted in love and in the Holy Trinity: "As you, Father, are in me and I am in you, may they also be in us." This prayer is not just a wish. It's a call; a mission: Jesus' dream!

Today, in a world fractured by division - politically, socially, spiritually - Jesus still prays. And He still waits; waits for each of us to respond by choosing unity and reconciliation by the guidance of the Holy Spirit. To live in unity means listening more than shouting, forgiving more than blaming, building bridges more than walls, and loving even when it's difficult.

A young man began to attend Mass at a parish divided over the color for new church carpet. Some wanted red, but others blue. Tempers flared. Mass attendance dipped. But one quiet widow kept praying, smiling, and bringing cookies to both groups. She visited the sick, sang in the choir, and never took sides. One day, the young man asked her: How do you stay so peaceful while everyone's arguing?" She said, *"I don't serve the carpet."*

I serve Christ. Jesus prayed that we be one. I'm trying to be the answer to His prayers." Unity is not uniformity - it's harmony in diversity. It's the Church breathing with one heart, inspired by the same Holy Spirit, moving in the direction of love, peace, and mission. Let us ask, "Am I an answer to Jesus' prayer? Or am I still part of the problem?" Let's not admire Jesus' prayer, but be it's living answer.

Pro-Life: Fetal Development, Month 2

The developing baby is now called a "fetus", which is Latin for "little one". She is making rapid progress developing all her external and internal organs. During the second month baby teeth form, and fingers and toes are developing. Her ears, nose, lips and tongue can now be seen. Brain waves can be recorded. The skeleton changes from cartilage to bone. The central nervous system is now functioning, and so forty muscle sets begin their first exercises. By 8 weeks all body systems are present. This little one can now suck her thumb!

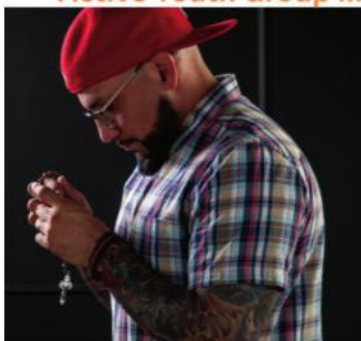

21. Oración de Esperanza de Jesús

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

Jesús ora, no solo por sus discípulos, sino por todos los que creemos por su palabra. Ora con esperanza, amor y anhelo. ¿Su deseo más profundo? «Que todos sean uno». Una oración por la unidad, no solo por una paz superficial, sino por la vida verdadera arraigada en el amor y en la Santísima Trinidad: «Como tú, Padre, estás en mí y yo en ti, que ellos también estén en nosotros». Esta oración no es solo un deseo. Es un llamado. Una misión. ¡El sueño de Jesús!

Hoy, en un mundo fracturado por la división —política, social y espiritual—, Jesús sigue orando. Y sigue esperando, esperando que cada uno de nosotros responda eligiendo la unidad y la reconciliación bajo la guía del Espíritu Santo. Vivir en unidad significa: escuchar más que gritar; perdonar más que culpar; construir puentes más que muros; amar incluso en las dificultades.

Un joven visitó una vez una pequeña parroquia rural dividida por el color de la nueva alfombra de la iglesia. Algunos querían rojo, otros azul. Los ánimos se caldearon. La asistencia a misa bajó. Pero una viuda silenciosa seguía rezando, sonriendo y llevando galletas a ambos grupos. Visitaba a los enfermos, cantaba en el coro y nunca tomaba partido. Un día, el joven le preguntó: "¿Cómo te mantienes tan tranquila cuando todos discuten?". Ella respondió: "No sirvo a la alfombra. Sirvo a Cristo. Jesús oró para que seamos uno. Intento ser la respuesta a sus oraciones".

La unidad no es uniformidad, es armonía en la diversidad. Es la Iglesia que respira con un solo corazón, inspirada por el mismo Espíritu Santo, avanzando hacia el amor, la paz y la misión. Preguntémonos: ¿Soy una respuesta a la oración de Jesús? ¿O sigo siendo parte del problema? No admiremos la oración de Jesús, sino que seamos su respuesta viva.
