22: Mission Complete to Begin

Dear brothers and sisters,
This month, we celebrate the high school graduations. Everyone is dressed up, smiling, holding certificates — but a bit uncertain. What comes next? Jesus “graduates,” in a sense, returning to the Father after completing His earthly mission.

What is next? He gives us a mission: “Be My witnesses.”

The Ascension is not the end — it is a launching pad, just like our graduation. Jesus didn’t go to heaven to leave us behind. He went ahead to lift us up. Just as our education, faith formation, and friendships prepare us for a purpose greater than ourselves, so does the Ascension prepare us to rise and move forward in faith.

I once met a woman who lost her husband and went through a period of deep sadness. But one day, she began volunteering with widows in her parish, offering comfort to those who were grieving. “I realized my pain had a purpose,” she said. “God didn’t abandon me - He was lifting me to help others.” Your wounds can become someone else’s healing. Your story can be someone else’s survival guide.

Like her, many of us stand staring at closed doors, lost in confusion. But the Ascension teaches us: *Don’t just look up in wonder; step out in faith.* God is not only above, He is within you, and He is sending you forward. St. Paul prays that we may have the “eyes of our hearts enlightened to understand the hope to which we are called”.

Don’t stand still. Don’t keep staring at the past. Let the Ascension lift your spirit. You were made for greater things. Now go continue His mission being His witness.

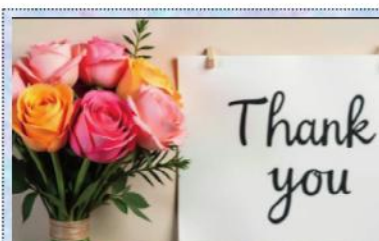

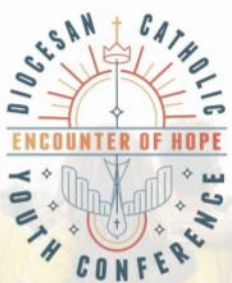

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

Este mes celebramos las graduaciones de preparatoria. Todos están elegantemente vestidos, sonrientes, con sus certificados en la mano, pero con cierta incertidumbre. ¿Qué sigue? Jesús se "gradúa", en cierto sentido, regresa al Padre tras completar su misión terrenal. ¿Qué sigue? Nos da una misión: "Ser mis testigos".

La Ascensión no es el final, es una plataforma de lanzamiento, como nuestra graduación. Jesús no fue al cielo para dejarnos atrás. Se adelantó para levantarnos. Así como nuestra educación, formación en la fe y amistades nos preparan para un propósito mayor que nosotros mismos, también la Ascensión nos prepara para levantarnos y avanzar en la fe.

Una vez conocí a una mujer que perdió a su esposo y atravesó un período de profunda tristeza. Pero un día, comenzó a ser voluntaria con las viudas de su parroquia, ofreciendo consuelo a quienes estaban de duelo. "Me di cuenta de que mi dolor tenía un propósito", dijo. "Dios no me abandonó; me estaba levantando para ayudar a los demás". Tus heridas pueden ser la sanación de alguien más. Tu historia puede ser la guía de supervivencia de alguien más.

Como ella, muchos de nosotros nos quedamos mirando puertas cerradas, perdidos en la confusión. Pero la Ascensión nos enseña: No te quedes con la mirada fija en el cielo; da un paso de fe. Dios no solo está arriba, sino que está dentro de ti y te está impulsando hacia adelante. San Pablo ora para que tengamos los ojos de nuestro corazón iluminados para comprender la esperanza a la que estamos llamados.

No te quedes quieto. No sigas mirando al pasado. Deja que la Ascensión te levante el ánimo. Fuiste creado para cosas mayores. Ahora ve y continúa su misión siendo su testigo. Oraciones y bendiciones! - Mons. Xavier

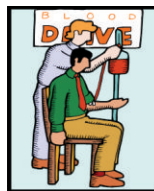

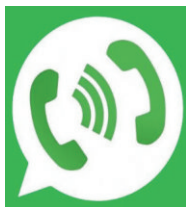

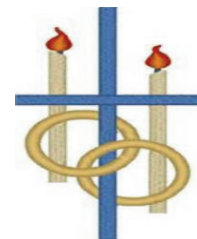
